

Comes now Adam's Mark Hotel, Alcoa Foil Products, Anheuser-Busch Companies, The Boeing Company, Ford Motor Company, General Motors Corporation, Holnam, Hussmann Refrigeration, Mallinckrodt, MEMC Electronic Materials, Monsanto, Procter & Gamble Manufacturing, and Ralston Purina, hereafter referred to as the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers ("MIEC"), and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075 and 4 CSR 240-2.080, files its Application to Intervene. In support of its Application to Intervene, the MIEC states as follows:

1. The MIEC is a group of large customers of Union Electric Company;
2. Union Electric Company's filing in this case could impact the rates and terms and conditions of service of its large customers.
3. As an organization of large customers, the MIEC's interest in this case is different than that of the general public.
4. The MIEC does not yet have sufficient information to take a position regarding Union Electric Company's application, but reserves the right to take positions on all issues that may affect its members in this case.
5. Granting the MIEC's proposed intervention would serve the public interest by assisting the development of a more complete record for decision by the Commission.

WHEREFORE, the MIEC requests that the Commission grant its Application to Intervene herein and make it a party to this case for all purposes.
