Callback feature enables the calling terminal to camp-on (camp-on is defined as having the network monitor the busy/idle status of the called address) to the last incoming calling directory number. When both lines are available, the calling subscriber is notified by a distinctive ring that the network is ready to place the call. When the subscriber picks up the telephone, the call is automatically placed (*89 to cancel).

3. Automatic Recall

This feature enables a user to automatically place a call to the last outgoing calling directory number associated with the terminal. The last outgoing calling number is defined as the address of the last party called by a user of the calling terminal.
