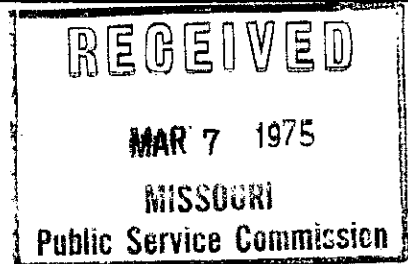

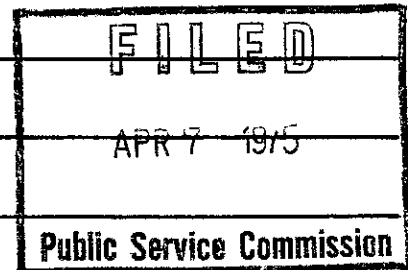

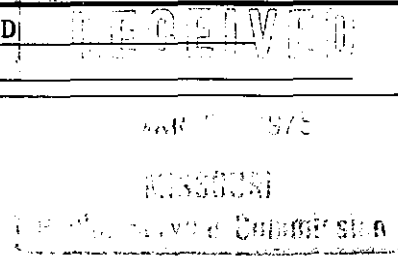

Rule 1 GENERAL

(a) Every Customer, upon signing an application for any service rendered by the Company, or upon taking of sewer service, shall be considered to have expressed consent to the Company's rates, rules and regulations.

(b) The Company reserves the right, subject to authority of the Public Service Commission of Missouri, to prescribe additional rates, rules or regulations or to alter existing rates, rules or regulations as it may from time to time deem necessary or proper.

Rule 2 DEFINITIONS

(a) The "COMPANY" means Roy-L Utilities, Inc.

(b) The "CUSTOMER" is any person, firm, corporation or governmental body receiving sewer service from Company or whose facilities are connected for utilizing such service.

(c) A "MAIN" or "LATERAL SEWER" is a pipeline which is owned and maintained by the Company, located on public property or on private easements, and used to transport sewage wastes to a central point for disposal.

**Rule 4 BILLS AND PAYMENT FOR SEWER SERVICE**

(a) Customers are liable for payment for all sewer service to the premises until notice has been received at the Company's office that the use of the sewer is not longer desired.

(b) Bills for sewer services will be mailed or delivered to the Customer's last address as shown by the records of the Company, but failure to receive a bill will not relieve the Customer from the obligation to pay the same. All bills and other accounts must be paid at the office of the Company or other place designated by Company. All bills for sewer service become delinquent after the due date stated on the bill and service may be discontinued after thirty (30) days' notice by the Company that the bill is delinquent unless the bill is paid according to said notice.

(c) When bills are rendered for a period of less than a complete billing period due to the connection or termination of service, the billing shall be for the proportionate part of the monthly charge, or where water consumption is the basis for the charge, at the appropriate rate for water consumed, or a proportionate part of the minimum, whichever is greater. Customers terminating with less than one month's service shall pay not less than the monthly minimum.

Rule 4 BILLS AND PAYMENT FOR SEWER SERVICE

(d) All sewer Customers whose sewer service ~~charges are determined~~ on the basis of water use who use in excess of 30,000 gallons of water per month, and can show to the satisfaction of the Company that a portion of the water as measured by the water meter or meters does not and can not enter the sanitary sewerage system, the Company may determine in such manner and by such method as it may deem practicable the percentage of metered water entering the sanitary sewerage system. Such percentage, when so determined, shall then constitute the basis of sewage service charges, provided, however, that the company in its discretion may require or permit the installation of additional meters at the expense of the Customer or other interested party in such a manner as to determine the quantity of water actually entering the sewerage system, in which case the quantity of water used to determine the sewage service charge shall be the quantity of water actually entering the sanitary sewerage system as so determined.

(e) The Company shall have the right to render bills quarterly and such bills shall be due and payable on the due date indicated on the bill.

(f) Where water usage determines sewer charges and a meter fails to register, or if the Company is unable to gain access to Customer's premise, the Customer's meter reading shall be estimated from the record of meter readings for a reasonable prior period and any adjustments applying to water shall also apply to sewer.

Rule 5 DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

(a) The company reserves the right upon the giving of not less than thirty (30) days' written notice to the customer, by certified mail, return receipt requested and a copy of said written notice forwarded to the Commission, to discontinue service for non-payment of sewer bills or for the violation of or refusal to comply with these rules and regulations.

(b) In case of violation by the Customer of any of the provisions of Rule 9 or if a condition shall exist which, in the opinion of the Company, renders further service to the Customer dangerous to his health and safety or to the health and safety of other parties, or for any unlawful reason, the Company may discontinue service immediately upon the giving of verbal or written notice to the customer.

(c) In areas where the Company provides water service, the Company reserves the right to request the water supply to be shut off in lieu of disconnecting Customer's sewer service. The reconnection charge for turn-on of the water service shall be the same as the turn-on fee cited in Rule #30 of the rules for water service. When the Company disconnects and plugs the Customer's sewer service at the point connection to the Company's main, the total cost of disconnection and re-establishment of service shall be at the Customer's expense.

(d) Discontinuance of sewer service to a premise for any reason shall not prevent the Company from pursuing any lawful remedy by action at law or otherwise for the collection of moneys due from the Customer.

(a) The company reserves the right upon the giving of not less than thirty (30) days' written notice to the Customer, by certified mail, return receipt requested and a copy of said written notice forwarded to the Commission, to discontinue service for non-payment of sewer bills or for violation of or refusal to comply with these rules and regulations.

(b) In case of violation by the Customer of any of the provisions of Rule 9 or if a condition shall exist which, in the opinion of the Company, renders further service to the Customer dangerous to his health and safety or to the health and safety of other parties, or for any unlawful reason, the Company may discontinue service immediately upon the giving of verbal or written notice to the Customer.

(c) In areas where the Company provides water service, the Company reserves the right to request the water supply to be shut off in lieu of disconnecting Customer's sewer service. When the Company disconnects and plugs the Customer's sewer service at the point of connection to the Company's main, the total cost of disconnection and re-establishment of service shall be at the Customer's expense.

(d) Discontinuance of sewage service to a premise for any reason shall not prevent the Company from pursuing any lawful remedy by action at law or otherwise for the collection of moneys due from the Customer.

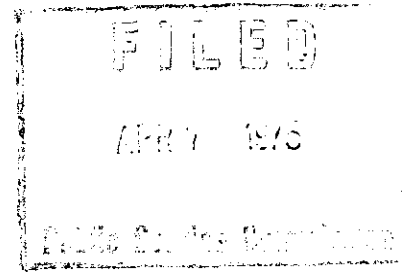

**Rule 8 INSIDE PIPING AND CUSTOMER SERVICE SEWERS**

(a) The Customer will provide the Customer's service sewer at his expense and risk. As a condition of service, inside piping and building sewer construction must meet all of the requirements of the latest editions of the Plumbing Rules and Regulations of the Administrative Building Council, Volume III, at the time of connection to the system. The Company shall deny service where footing drains, downspouts, or other sources of surface water are permitted to enter the system through either the inside piping or through the building sewer.

(b) A separate and independent Customer service sewer shall be required for every building; except where one building stands at the rear of another on an interior lot and no private sewer is available or can be constructed to the rear building through an adjoining alley, court, yard, or driveway, the Customer's service sewer from the front building may be extended to the rear building and the whole considered as one Customer's service sewer.

(c) Old Customer service sewers may be used in connection with new buildings only when they are found on examination and test to meet all requirements of the Company.

(d) The Customer's service sewer shall be case iron soil pipe, ASTM specification or equal; vitrified clay sewer pipe, ASTM specification or equal; or other suitable material approved by the Company. Joints shall be tight and waterproof. Any part of the Customer's service sewer that is located within ten feet of a water service pipe shall be constructed of cast iron soil pipe. Cast iron pipes may be required where the Customer's service sewer is exposed to damage by tree roots. If installed in filled or unstable ground, the Customer's service sewer shall be of a cast iron soil pipe, except that non-metallic material may be accepted if laid on a suitable concrete bed or cradle as approved by the Company.

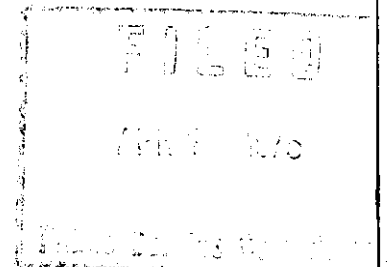
(e) The size and slope of the Customer's service sewer shall be subject to the approval of the Company, but in no event shall the diameter be less than four (4) inches for a single family residence. The slope of such four (4) inch pipe shall not be less than one eighth (1/8) inch per foot.

(f) Whenever possible the Customer's service sewer shall be brought to the building at an elevation below the basement floor. No building sewer shall be laid parallel to or within three (3) feet of any bearing wall. The depth shall be sufficient to afford protection from frost. The Customer's service sewer shall be laid at a uniform grade and in straight alignment insofar as possible. Changes in direction shall be made only with properly curved pipes and fittings.

(g) In all buildings in which any building drain is too low to permit gravity flow to the Company's main, sanitary sewage carried by such drains shall be lifted by approved artificial means and discharged to the building sewer. No water operated sewage ejector shall be used.

(h) All excavations required for the installation of a Customer's service sewer shall be open trench work unless otherwise approved by the Company. Pipe laying and backfill shall be performed in accordance with ASTM specifications except that no backfill shall be placed until the work has been inspected by the Company. Only those jointing materials and methods which are approved by the Company may be used.

(i) The connection of the Customer's service sewer into the main shall be made at the "Y" branch, if such branch is available at a suitable location. If the Company's main is twelve (12) inches in diameter or less and no properly located "Y" branch in the company's main at the location specified by the Company, a "Y" branch must be installed. Where the Company's main is greater than twelve (12) inches in diameter, and no properly located "Y" branch is available, a neat hole may be cut in the Company's main and an approved saddle installed to receive the Customer's service sewer. The invert of the Customer's service sewer at the point of connection shall be at the same or at a higher elevation than the invert of the Company's main. A smooth neat joint shall be made, and the connection made secure and water tight by encasement in concrete.

(j) It is understood that all facilities above described are to be constructed and maintained by the applicant subject to the approval of any authorized inspector, and in accordance with the Rules and information of the Company in force at that time.

(g) When required by the Company, the Customer service sewer carrying industrial wastes shall include a suitable control manhole in the Customer service sewer to facilitate observation, sampling and measurement of the wastes. Such manhole, when required, shall be accessibly and safely located, and shall be constructed in accordance with plans approved by the Company. The manhole shall be installed by the Customer at his expense, and shall be maintained by him so as to be safe and accessible at all times.
