Sprint Clarity is designed to satisfy subscriber's single location telecommunications needs as well as multi-location networking requirements via subscriber defined invoicing and reporting coupled with retroactive volume discounts which are based on aggregated usage (including Sprint Clarity FÖNCARD surcharges) from all Sprint Clarity locations within a subscriber's hierarchy. Sprint Clarity FÖNCARD is available on a stand-alone basis or as a feature of the Sprint Clarity outbound options. Sprint Clarity domestic calls are billed an eighteen second minimum. After the initial eighteen second minimum, calls will be billed in six second minimum, calls will be billed in six second increments.
