On March 6, 2013, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Unity Telecom, LLC ("Unity") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide basic local telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. Staff's motion also requests the Company's eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") designation be revoked. The Commission granted Unity a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Number TA-2000-44. The Commission granted the company ETC designation in File No. CO-2010-0054.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.
