ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF AND DIRECTING RESPONSE

Effective Date: March 9, 2011

On March 8, 2011, AT&T Communications and AT&T Missouri filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend and investigate a tariff filed by IntelePeer, Inc. IntelePeer filed the tariff in question on February 11, 2011, and it will become effective on March 13, 2011, unless the Commission acts to suspend it before that date.

The AT&T companies' motion explains that the IntelePeer tariff would modify existing intrastate switched access tariff provisions. The AT&T companies do not oppose the goal of revising the tariff provisions, but contend the tariff proposed by IntelePeer is vague, ambiguous, and should be clarified before it is allowed to go into effect.

On March 8, 2011, Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion in support of suspending the tariff. Staff's motion states the proposed tariff

contains provisions which are usually not allowed in Missouri telecommunication tariffs. Staff also requests additional time to review the tariff, address AT&T's concerns and any additional concerns following Staff's review, and to request changes to the proposed tariff.

The Commission does not have sufficient time to further investigate the AT&T companies' concerns about the tariff before the effective date of that tariff. Therefore, pursuant to the authority granted by Section 392.230.3, RSMo, Supp. 2009, the Commission will suspend IntelPeer's tariff for 60 days to allow sufficient time to fully consider the objections raised by the AT&T companies.

In order to promptly begin that review process, the Commission will direct IntelPeer to file a response to the AT&T companies' motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff submitted under Tariff File No. YL-2011-0406, on February 11, 2011, by IntelPeer, Inc., is suspended from March 13, 2011, to May 12, 2011.

2. The specific tariff suspended is:

IntelPeer, Inc.
P.S.C. MO No. 3

3. IntelPeer, Inc. shall respond to AT&T Companies' Motion to Suspend no later than March 21, 2011.

4. Any requests to intervene shall be filed no later than March 21, 2011.

5. Any other party or potential intervenor that wishes to respond to AT&T Companies' Motion to Suspend shall do so no later than March 21, 2011.

6. This order shall become effective March 9, 2011.
