ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

The Commission is granting the *Staff Motion to Suspend* ("motion") and suspending the tariff sheets ("tariff") of tw telecom of kansas city, Ilc ("the Company").

The Company filed tariff sheets ("tariff") on April 6. On May 3, Staff filed the motion with a supporting affidavit. Staff asks the Commission to suspend the tariff for 60 days, which the Commission may do as follows:

Whenever there shall be filed with the commission by any telecommunications company . . . any [tariff], the commission . . . at once, and . . . , but upon reasonable notice, [and] upon filing with such [tariff] and delivering to the telecommunications company affected thereby a statement in writing of its reasons for such suspension, may suspend the operation of such [tariff] and defer the use of such [tariff], but not for a longer period than sixty days beyond the time when such [tariff] would otherwise go into effect [.²]

The tariff will be effective on May 6 absent Commission action and Staff charges that the tariff is facially contrary to statute.

Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion and suspend the tariff.
