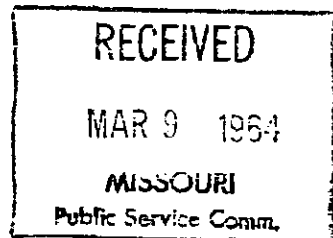

## A. GENERAL

1. This Tariff is subject to and governed by the Rules and Regulations, which parts as they now exist or as they may be revised, added to or supplemented by superseding pages or issues, are made a part of this Tariff.
2. The schedules of basic monthly exchange rates applicable within and outside the base rate areas in the various exchange areas for the services offered therein are shown in B., Rates, of this Tariff. Basic exchange service as offered in this Tariff is comprised of two elements:

a. Exchange Access

Serving central office line equipment and all outside plant facilities needed to connect the serving central office with the customer premises. These facilities are Telephone Company-provided and maintained and, with the installation of inside wire and outlet of a working service point, provide access to and from the telecommunications network for message toll service and for local calling by the customer.

b. Station Set (Telephone)

Charges for Telephone Company-provided equipment are as specified under Miscellaneous Equipment in this Tariff. No station set element applies when customer-provided equipment is used in lieu of Telephone Company-provided equipment.

3. The monthly exchange access rates shown in this Tariff are payable in advance and entitle the customer to exchange dial telephone service through Company-owned facilities.

## C. DS1 Channel Service

## 1. Description

DS1 Channel Service is an intraLATA digital service that provides a DS1 digital facility and channelization capability using a digital, high capacity T-1 interface. DS1 Channel is provisioned for multiple voice grade channel equivalents (DSO) where 24 voice grade channels are equal to a DS1. DS1 Channel Service provides local channels and/or interoffice channels for analog voice services, analog data service, and digital data services. The Telephone Company will provide channelization capability in the Central Office whereas channelization equipment on a customer's premises is provided by the customer. The customer may activate any number or combination of channels within a DS1 Channel Service package as long as the total number of voice grade equivalent channels activated by the customer does not exceed 24 channels.

## 2. Rates

The rate for DS1 Channel Service is the effective Local Exchange Access Line Service rate multiplied by the number of voice grade channels in service.

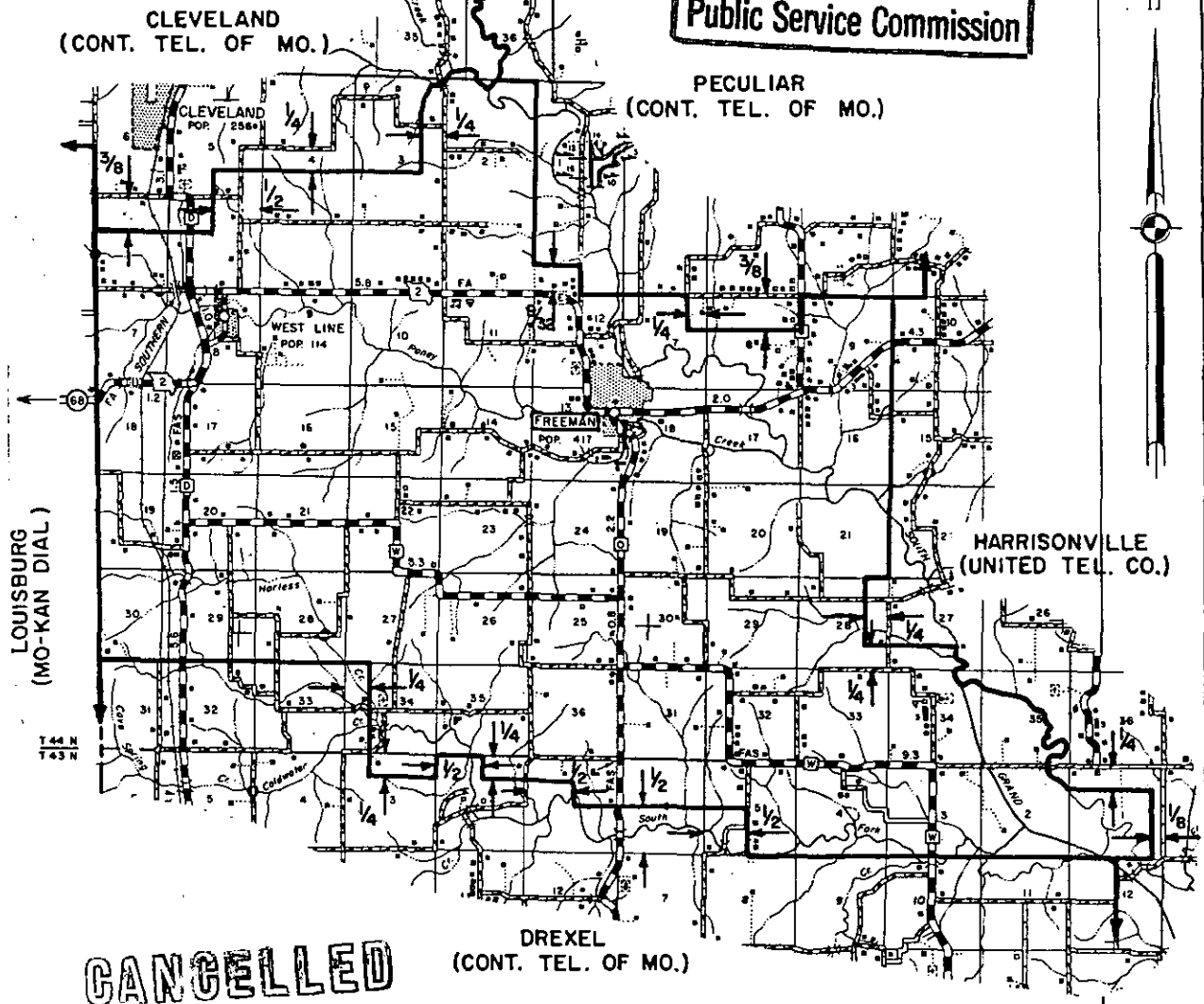

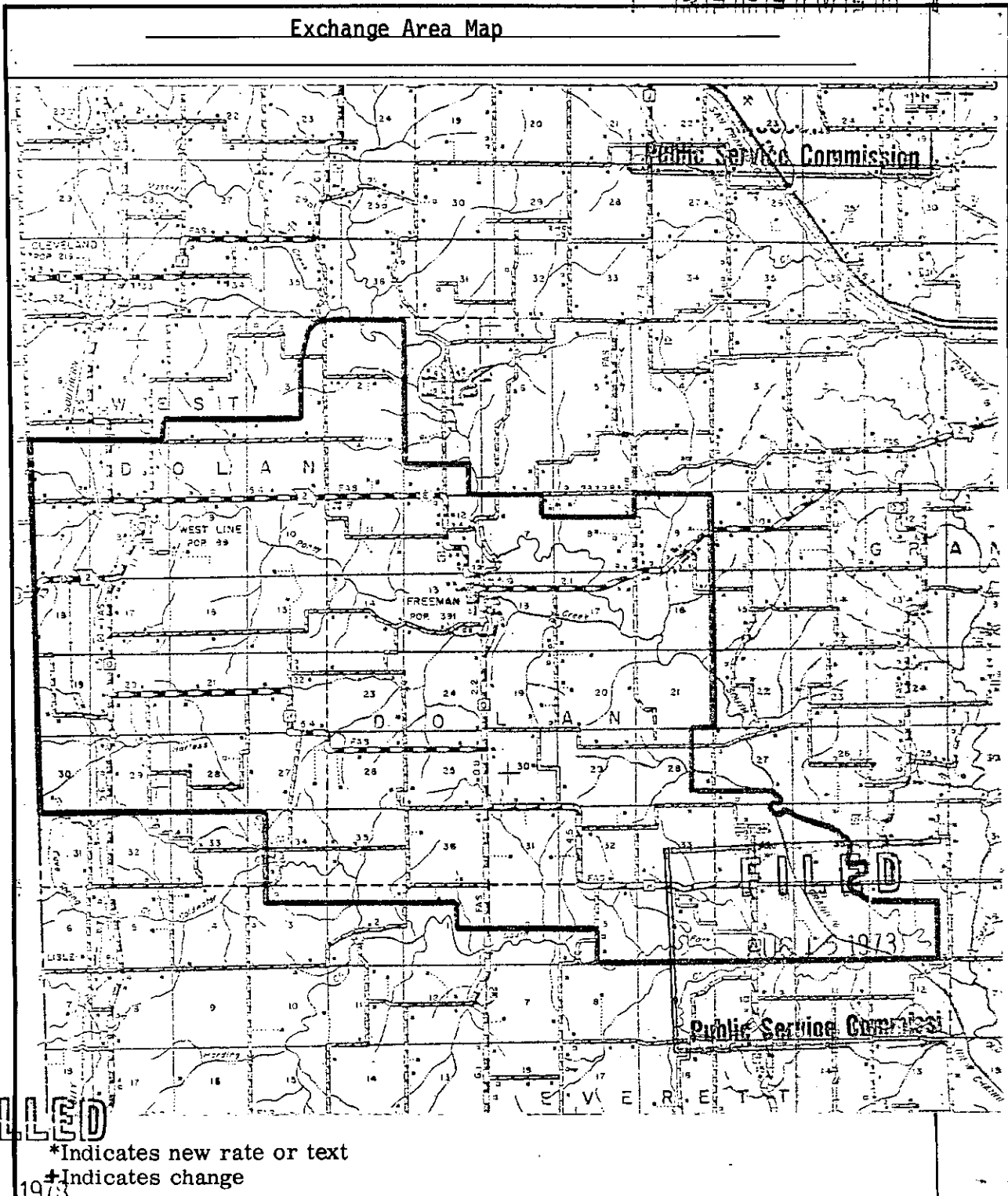

## VI. PUBLIC TELEPHONE SERVICE

- A. A public telephone is an exchange station installed at the Company's option, equipped with a coin collection device, at a location chosen or accepted by the Company as suitable and necessary for furnishing service to the general public.
- B. Persons with whom arrangements are made by the Company for the installation of Public Telephone are considered as the agents of the Company in serving the public.
- C. Public telephones are installed upon agent signing established forms of application, without specific term, terminable by either an agent or the Company upon written notice.
- D. No listings in the directory are allowed in connection with public telephone service.
- E. Local messages from Public Telephones are charged for at 25 cents each.
- F. Standard long-distance toll charges apply to all long-distance calls. Charges for operator services on calls initiating through public pay stations shall be the same as charges for such services rendered through public pay stations shall be the same as charges for such services rendered through private instruments.

2. Eligibility Requirements

The following requirements shall be used by the company to determine the eligibility of a subscriber for Link Up Missouri assistance.

  - a. Subscribers must have lived at an address where there has been no telephone service for at least three months prior to the date that assistance is requested.
  - b. Eligible subscribers must not have received this assistance within the last two years.
  - c. Subscribers must not be a dependent for federal income tax purposes, unless the subscriber is more than 60 years of age.
  - d. Subscriber is currently receiving MEDICAID/medical assistance payments from the State of Missouri, and has provided their Department of Social Services Client Number (DCN) to the Company.

Of the eligibility requirements listed above, items a., b., c., will be certified by the subscriber, and item d. will be State certified by the Department of Social Services.

(1) These do not include other charges that may be required at the initiation of service such as security deposit, contributions in aid of construction, customer advance

- (1) Call Forwarding - an arrangement whereby incoming calls may be transferred to another telephone number by signaling a prefix code and the telephone number of the service to which calls are to be transferred. Calls forwarded by this feature are subject to Applicable long distance message charges. These calls are also subject to transmission limitations.

##### A. General Regulations

1. Lifeline service is a discounted voice telephony service available to qualifying residential subscribers.

4. MINIMUM SERVICE PERIOD: No telephone will be installed for a shorter period than three (3) months, after which time the service may be terminated at any time upon five (5) days' written notice to the Company, whereupon all bills for service rendered shall immediately become due and payable.

At the request of the customer, one extension may be connected to the Customer-Owned Coin Telephone Access Line.

- (1) All attachments of Customer-Owned Coin Telephones to the network must be made pursuant to the rules and regulations set forth in this Tariff. Customer-Owned Coin Telephone Service is a two-way or, optionally, one-way originating only business exchange access line service. This service includes the serving central office line equipment, all outside plant facilities needed to connect the serving central office with the customer's premises and the network interface, and selective class of call screening treatment where and when facilities are available. These facilities are Telephone Company-provided and maintained and provide access to and from the telecommunications network for long distance service and local calling.
- (2) Selective class of call screening treatment allows the customer to restrict outgoing operator-handled calls placed over the Telephone Company's network, from the service point to only those calls which are charged to a called telephone, a third number or a calling card account. The Telephone Company will not be responsible for screening those calls placed over the network of any carrier other than the Telephone Company or placed through non-local exchange telephone company operators.

Note: (1) For purposes of this Tariff, the term "customer" is defined as the party who is responsible for payment of the Customer-Owned Coin Telephone Access Line.

Customer-Owned Coin Telephones must be connected to a Customer-Owned Coin Telephone Access Line, at rates specified in this tariff. A maximum of one customer owned, coin telephone and one extension may be connected to a Customer-Owned Coin Telephone Access Line.

Wherever available, selective class of call screening must be provided on all Customer Owned Coin Telephone Service Exchange Access Lines. Any customer who offers Customer-Owned Coin Telephone Service where Selective Class of Call Screening is not available, nonetheless assumes full and complete responsibility for all calls billed to his line.

No variation, alteration or refashioning of the screening codes, billing codes, or applicable access or other general provisions of this Selective Class of Call Screening treatment will be permitted.

Any customer who offers Customer-Owned Coin Telephone assumes full and complete responsibility for all calls billed to his line.

Directory listings may be provided under the regulations governing the furnishing of listings for business subscribers in the Telephone Company Tariff.

For Customer-Owned Coin Telephone Service, a network interface will be installed at a location determined by the Telephone Company which is reasonably accessible to the premises to be served by the Customer Owned Coin Telephone. The normal location would be in close proximity to the protector or equivalent.

The network interface is the point of connection with the telecommunications network and is the termination of the Customer-Owned Coin Telephone Exchange Access Line.

2. Responsibility of the Customer

The customer shall be responsible for the installation, operation and maintenance of the customer-provided coin telephone used in connection with this service.

Where portions of an existing Public or Semi-Public installation such as shelves, enclosure, etc. are left in place and desired for purchase by the customer to Customer-Owned Coin Telephone Service, charges will be quoted upon such request.

The customer shall be responsible for the payment of all charges for service provided to the customer pursuant to the Company's Tariffs.

## A. SALE OF TERMINAL EQUIPMENT

1. - B. Must be able to access 911 Emergency Service, where available, at no charge and without using a coin.
- C. Must be able to access Directory Assistance.
- D. Must be able to complete local and toll calls.
- E. The customer must provide on or near its phones such consumer information as required by State and Federal law.
- F. The Customer-Owned Coin Telephone Service customer shall indemnify and hold The Company harmless from any and all loss, damage and expense occasioned by or arising out of claims for injury to persons or damage to property caused by or contributed to by the provision of detailed toll billing records to the Customer-Owned Coin Telephone Service customer by The Company, including but not limited to, any disclosure of said detailed toll billing records by the Customer-Owned Coin Telephone customer.
- G. Must comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations concerning the use of this type of telephone by disabled and/or hearing impaired persons.

The customer must obtain all necessary certificates/approvals from the Missouri Public Service Commission and Commission's Rules and Regulations regarding the use of customer-provided, coin telephones.

Customer-provided coin telephones are provided only for the use of customers and authorized users.
