## ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFFS

On November 20, 2013, Peaceful Valley Service Company ("Peaceful Valley") initiated small water and sewer company rate increase actions, pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050. Consistent with the terms of a disposition agreement entered into by Peaceful Valley and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Peaceful Valley submitted revised tariff sheets. In an April 30<sup>th</sup> order, the Commission suspended Peaceful Valley's tariffs, which had a June 15, 2014 effective date, until August 22<sup>nd</sup>.

The Commission requested additional information on Peaceful Valley's planned wastewater treatment improvements that were not addressed in the disposition agreement. On August 15, 2014, Staff filed its Staff *Report* providing such information.

In order for the Commission to fully consider the *Staff Report*, the Commission will suspend the tariffs for an additional period.
