1. A public telephone is an exchange station installed at the Telephone Company's option, in charge of an attendant, or equipped with coin collecting devices, at a location chosen or accepted by the company as suitable necessary for furnishing service to the general public.
  2. Persons with whom arrangements are made by the Telephone Company for the installation of Public Telephones are considered as the agents of the Company in serving the public.
  3. Public telephones are installed upon the agent signing established forms of application, without term, terminable by either agent or the Telephone Company upon written notice.
  4. No listings in the directory are allowed in connection with public telephone service.
  5. Local messages from Public Telephones are charged for at 10 cents each, for each five minutes, or fraction thereof, and toll messages at the Company's established toll rates.
  6. Public telephones will be installed only on one party lines.

## B. SUBSCRIBER COIN BOX SERVICE

1. Coin Box Service is an arrangement under which a subscriber station is equipped with a collecting device which is under control of the subscriber. He will be in possession of the coin box keys and will empty the coin box as he sees fit.

This service is established upon application by individual business subscribers and is offered at locations where, in the opinion of the Telephone Company, the installation of a Public Telephone is not warranted.

2. The Telephone Company does not undertake to provide booths for housing coin box service telephones, but the subscriber may at his option, provide at his own cost, suitable booths, shelves, or cubicles for such purpose.
3. Subscribers to coin box service telephone service are entitled to regular listings in the Telephone Company's official directory and may advertise such numbers for incoming calls and business purposes subject to the Rules and Regulations found elsewhere in these tariffs.
4. Local messages from coin box service telephones are charged for at the rate of 10 cents each, for each five minutes, or fraction thereof, and toll messages are charged for at the Telephone Company's established toll rates.

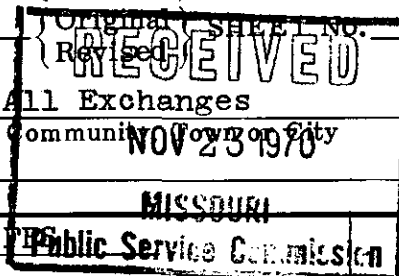

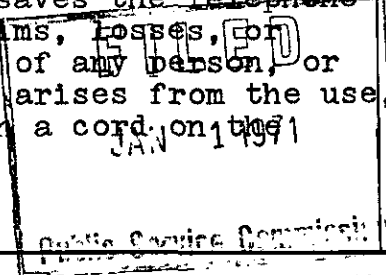

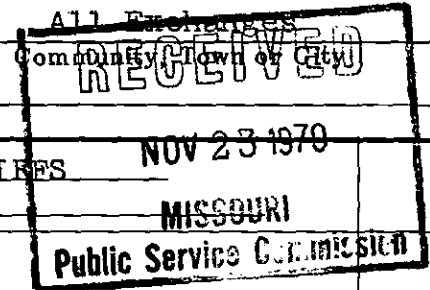
