## ORDER APPROVING INTEREXCHANGE AND NONSWITCHED LOCAL EXCHANGE CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Issue Date: March 2, 2006 Effective Date: March 16, 2006

This order grants EliteView, LLC d/b/a GroveLine a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services, restricted to providing dedicated private line services, and approves the company's proposed tariff.

EliteView applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission on January 30, 2006, for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Sections 392.410, RSMo Supp. 2005, through 392.450, RSMo 2000. EliteView asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and to waive certain statutes and rules as authorized by Sections 392.361 and 392.420. EliteView is a Massachusetts corporation

with its principal office located at 350 Myles Standish Boulevard, 2nd Floor, Taunton, Massachusetts 02780.

The Commission issued a Notice of Applications for Intrastate Certificates of Service Authority and Opportunity to Intervene on February 7, 2006, directing parties wishing to intervene to file their requests by February 22, 2006. No requests for intervention were filed.

EliteView filed a proposed tariff in conjunction with its application with an effective date of March 16, 2006. EliteView's tariff describes the rates, rules, and regulations it intends to use, identifies EliteView as a competitive company, and lists the waivers requested. EliteView intends to provide interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services, restricted to providing dedicated private line services services.

In its Memorandum filed on February 28, 2006, the Staff of the Commission recommended that the Commission grant EliteView a certificate of interexchange service authority and a certificate of service authority for local exchange telecommunications service on condition that this authority be restricted to providing dedicated private line services. Staff recommended that the Commission grant EliteView competitive status, and waiver of the statutes and rules listed in the Notice. Staff recommended that the Commission approve the proposed tariff to become effective on March 16, 2006.

The Commission finds that competition in the intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications markets is in the public interest and EliteView shall be granted certificates of service authority. The Commission finds that the services EliteView proposes to offer are competitive and EliteView shall be classified as a

competitive company. The Commission finds that waiving the statutes and Commission rules set out in the ordered paragraph below is reasonable and not detrimental to the public interest.

The Commission finds that EliteView's proposed tariff details the services, equipment, and pricing it proposes to offer, and is similar to tariffs approved for other Missouri certificated interexchange and local exchange carriers. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff filed on January 30, 2006, shall be approved to become effective on March 16, 2006.

The Commission reminds the company that failure to comply with its regulatory obligations may result in the assessment of penalties against it. These regulatory obligations include, but are not limited to, the following:

- A) The obligation to file an annual report, as established by Section 392.210, RSMo 2000. Failure to comply with this obligation will make the utility liable to a penalty of \$100 per day for each day that the violation continues. 4 CSR 240-3.540 requires telecommunications utilities to file their annual report on or before April 15 of each year.
- B) The obligation to pay an annual assessment fee established by the Commission, as required by Section 386.370, RSMo 2000.
- C) The obligation to comply with all relevant laws and regulations, as well as orders issued by the Commission. If the company fails to comply, it is subject to penalties for noncompliance ranging from \$100 to \$2,000 per day of noncompliance, pursuant to Section 386.570, RSMo 2000.
- D) The obligation to keep the Commission informed of its current address and telephone number.

Furthermore, the company is reminded that, if it is a corporation, non-attorneys may not represent the company before the Commission. Instead, the corporation must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Missouri.

In addition, the company is reminded that Section 392.410.5, RSMo Supp. 2005, renders the company's certificate of service authority null and void one year from the date of this order unless it has exercised its authority under that certificate.

#### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. EliteView, LLC d/b/a GroveLine is granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, subject to all applicable statutes and Commission rules except as specified in this order.
- 2. EliteView, LLC d/b/a GroveLine is granted a certificate of service authority to provide nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, limited to providing dedicated private line services, subject to all applicable statutes and Commission rules except as specified in this order.
- 3. The certification granted herein is conditioned upon the company's compliance with the regulatory obligations in this order.
- 4. EliteView, LLC d/b/a GroveLine is classified as a competitive telecommunications company. Application of the following statutes and regulatory rules shall be waived:
