 - T.N.C.'s services are not mileage sensitive. T.N.C. proposes to resell telecommunications services

including travel service available through toll-free access, and directory assistance. T.N.C. resells

transmission capacity of other telecommunications carriers and does not propose to construct any

facilities in Missouri. Calls originate over local exchange carrier or competitive local exchange

carrier facilities to the underlying carrier.

3. T.N.C.'s statutory representation in the state of Missouri is:

4. T.N.C. has no plans to install or construct transmission facilities in Missouri. The Company will

The above-referenced rules and statutory provisions have been waived with regard to other interexchange carriers in prior cases. These rules or statutory provisions are principally designed to apply to noncompetitive telecommunications carriers. It would be inconsistent with the goal and purpose of Section 392.530 to apply them to a competitive telecommunications carrier such as the Applicant.

- 14. T.N.C. states that it has no annual report or assessment fees that are overdue in Missouri.
- 15. T.N.C. states that it has no pending action or final judgements or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involves Customer service or rates.

16. T.N.C. submits that the public interest will be served by Commission approval of this application because T.N.C.'s proposed services will create an enhance competition and expand Customer service options consistent with the legislative goals set forth in the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo. Prompt approval of this application also will expand the availability of innovative, high quality, and reliable telecommunications services within the state of Missouri.
