After receiving input from the parties, the Commission set three local public hearings. On September 23, 2015, the Office of Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to move the October 19 local public hearing from Shelbina to Shelbyville. The motion represents that no party objects.

The Commission will change the location of the Shelby County hearing. The Commission will also reissue public notice of the hearings.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing on Monday, October 19, 2015, beginning at 6 p.m. and continuing until all persons who wish to testify have done so, in the Gymnasium, North Shelby High School, 3071 Highway 15, Shelbyville, Missouri.
2. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing on Monday, October 26, 2015, beginning at 6 p.m. and continuing until all persons who wish to testify have done so,

in the Multipurpose Room, Schuyler County R-1 Elementary School, 21701 U.S. Highway 63, Queen City, Missouri.

3. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing on Tuesday, October 27, 2015, beginning at 6 p.m. and continuing until all persons who wish to testify have done so, in Student Union Activities Room 3200, Truman State University, 901 South Franklin Street, Kirksville, Missouri.

4. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commissions of Shelby, Adair, and Schuyler counties.

5. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Shelby, Adair, and Schuyler Counties, and to the news media serving therein.

6. This order shall be effective when issued.
