MINIMUM USAGE CHARGE - in addition to the Meter Charge, a monthly minimum usage charge for any month shall be equal to the commodity rate, times the greater of 1) 60% of the maximum usage during any of the months of June, July, August, or September in the twelve (12) month period preceding the month for which the bill is to be rendered or 2) 450,000 gallons or 3) actual usage as registered by the meter.

Rate I Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS)

<u>DESCRIPTION</u> - Rate I is designed to recover the costs associated with the Company's eligible main, valve, and hydrant replacements, main relocations, and main cleaning and relining projects. This ISRS rate is calculated and implemented in accordance with the provisions of sections 393.1000 to 393.1006 RSMO. Any future changes to this rate will also be made in accordance with those provisions.

<u>APPLICABILITY</u> - This rate is applicable to any customer class who benefits from the subject utility plant projects eligible for ISRS recovery. The surcharge is calculated consistent with the customer class cost-of-service study recognized by the Missouri Commission in a Company's recent applicable general rate proceeding.

RATE COMPONENTS - In addition to the other charges provided for in the Company's tariffs, a separate charge for the ISRS will apply for service rendered on and after the effective date.

Minimum Customer Charge Rate for Low-Income Customers

AVAILABILITY- Customers that default on payments for two (2) consecutive months will no longer be eligible for this rate, and will not be allowed to requalify for twelve (12) months. Customers must reestablish eligibility on an annual basis. This rate will be available until the effective date of new rates in Missouri American Water's next general rate proceeding.

TARIFF QUALIFICATIONS

The program administrator will determine a customer's eligibility using the following criteria: the customer's household earnings meet the low-income guidelines for the Missouri Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). Residential customers, who demonstrate a financial need and qualify for LIHEAP, should contact a local Community Action Agency referenced below or any subsequent program administrator whose contact information may be found on Missouri American Water's web site. Upon qualification for LIHEAP, residential customers with a 5/8" meter will receive a discount of 80% of the fixed 5/8" meter minimum customer charge. The current fixed monthly 5/8" meter minimum customer charge for St. Joseph, Brunswick, Platte County, and Lawson is \$9.00, the discount applied to the customer's monthly bill would be \$7.20.

Rules and Regulations Governing the Rendering of Water Service

- Q. When a tap has been made to serve a private fire protection service line and a customer or owner decides either (a) not to install the private fire protection service line and piping and to cancel the private protection billing or (b) to terminate existing private fire protection service, the following are required:
 - 1. A written request for termination of private fire protection service from the customer and owner of the premises; and
 - 2. Proof that the appropriate fire protection authority has been notified that private fire protection service will not be available at the premises; and
 - 3. Destruction of the tap as provided in Rule 4. In the case of a "split water service line," that portion of the water service line providing the private fire protection service may be made unusable as directed by the Company in lieu of tap destruction.
- R. If the above requirements are not fulfilled, the Company will continue the Private Fire Protection billing in accordance with Rate Tariff F. If Private Fire Protection bills are not paid, the company may do either or both of the following:
 - 1. Transfer the unpaid balance to any other service account of the customer, and/or
 - 2. Attempt to notify the appropriate fire protection authority and the owner of the premises if either are known to the Company, and then proceed to terminate Private Fire Protection service by destroying the tap. In the case of a "split water service line" destruction of the tap will also terminate domestic service. The actual costs of Company's work, including excavation, will be billed to the customer. A new tap and service restoration will not be permitted until all bills, including any transferred bills are paid.

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
