Access Line - An arrangement which connects the Customer's telephone to a Clear World designated switching center or point of presence.

Authorized User - A person, firm, corporation, or any other entity authorized by the Customer to utilize the Carrier's service.

Authorization Code - A pre-defined series of numbers to be dialed by the Customer or Authorized User upon access to the Carrier's Travel Card Service network to identify the caller and validate the caller's authorization to use the services provided.

2.5 Deposits

The Company reserves the right to examine the credit record of the Customer. If the Customer's financial condition is unknown or unacceptable to the Company, the Customer may be required to provide the Company with a security deposit intended to guarantee payment of bills for service. The amount of the security deposit for a new Customer shall not exceed two (2) months or sixty (60) days total billing (including toll and taxes) of estimated usage. For an existing Customer, the amount of the security deposit shall not exceed the highest billing of two (2) consecutive months or sixty (60) days (including toll and taxes) of actual usage within the preceding six (6) months. All deposits are subject to review based on the actual usage of the Customer and may be adjusted accordingly. The fact that a security deposit has been made in no way relieves the Customer from the prompt payment of bills upon presentation. Interest at the rate of one percent (1%) above the prime lending rate as published in the <u>Wall Street Journal</u> for the last business day of September will be credited to the customer's account. This rate will be adjusted annually October 1 of each year.

2.6 Advance Payments

The Company does not collect advance payments for service.

2.7 Taxes

The Company reserves the right to bill any and all applicable taxes and fees in addition to normal rates and charges for services provided to the customer. Taxes and fees include, but are not limited to: Federal Excise Tax, State Sales Tax, Municipal Tax, and Gross Receipts Tax. 2.10 **Payment for Service**

The Customer is responsible for payment of all charges for services and equipment furnished to the Customer or to an Authorized User of the Customer by Clear World. 3.3 Calculation of Distance

Usage charges for mileage sensitive services vary based on the type of service subscribed to by the Customer. For services utilizing switched access, mileage measurements for rate schedules are based on the distance in airline miles between rate centers associated with the originating and terminating stations. For services utilizing dedicated access, mileage measurements for rate schedules are based on the distance in airline miles between the Clear World network access point associated with the station utilizing Dedicated Access Origination/Termination and the rate center associated with the called/calling station.
