PROTECTIVE ORDER

On May 21, 2018, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to section 393.170, RSMo 2016. The CCN would authorize Ameren Missouri to construct, own, and operate a wind generation facility to be constructed in Schuyler and Adair Counties in Missouri. Ameren Missouri's application also seeks approval of a Renewable Energy Standard Cost Recovery Mechanism (RESRAM), and a waiver of certain Commission rules.

Along with its application, Ameren Missouri filed a motion for protective order seeking additional protection for certain commercially sensitive information regarding wind generation that will be filed, or otherwise disclosed, in this case. Ameren Missouri seeks leave to designate that information as Highly Confidential as permitted by the Commission's confidential information rule, 4 CSR 240-2.135(4).

The Commission took up Ameren Missouri's motion for protective order on the record at the procedural conference held on June 8, 2018. No party opposed that motion, and it was granted.

The specific extra protections to be afforded to the information designated by Ameren Missouri as highly confidential are described in this order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Competitively sensitive information designated by Ameren Missouri as highly confidential shall be disclosed only to attorneys of record for all parties, to state agency parties and their employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, and to designated outside experts of any non-state agency party.
- 2. Except for attorneys of record for all parties, and employees of state agency employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, all persons authorized to access "confidential" information in this case shall complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit A.
- 3. Except for attorneys of record for all parties, and employees of state agency employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, all persons authorized to access "highly confidential" information in this case shall complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit B.
 - 4. This order shall be effective when issued.
