ORDER SETTING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING AND DIRECTING NOTICE

On May 21, 2018, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to section 393.170, RSMo 2016. The CCN would authorize Ameren Missouri to construct, own, and operate a wind generation facility to be constructed in Schuyler and Adair Counties in Missouri. Ameren Missouri's application also seeks approval of a Renewable Energy Standard Rate Adjustment Mechanism (RESRAM), and a waiver of certain Commission rules. The Commission has adopted a procedural schedule that indicates a local public hearing will be held after rebuttal testimony is filed on August 17. That local public hearing will be scheduled by this order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make an informational presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the beginning of the local public hearing.
- 2. Ameren Missouri, the Commission's Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall each prepare a one-page statement outlining their current assessment of the case, and shall bring sufficient copies for distribution at the question-and-answer session that begins the local public hearing.
- 3. Ameren Missouri, the Commission's Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer session.
- 4. Any other party, at its discretion, may prepare a statement and make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question and answer session.
- 5. The Commission will hold a local public hearing at Schuyler R-I Elementary School Multipurpose Room, 21701 US Highway 63, Queen City, Missouri, 63561, on Tuesday, August 21, 2018, beginning at 6:00 p.m.
- 6. The local public hearing will be held in a facility that meets the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. - 7. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send a copy of this order to the county commissions of Adair and Schuyler Counties in Missouri.

- 8. The Public Policy and Outreach Department of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send a copy of this order to members of the General Assembly and to the media that serve Adair and Schuyler Counties in Missouri.
