ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

On May 10, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the certificate of service authority granted to Cable & Wireless USA, Inc. The company was granted a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services in Case No. TA-2001-505. Staff informs the Commission that in November of 2002, the Commission approved a transfer of the company's Missouri assets. Staff further states that in December of 2003, the company sought bankruptcy protection and in March of 2004, sent a letter to the Commission relinquishing its certificate. Finally, Staff states that the Missouri Secretary of State reports that the company's certificate to do business in the state was revoked for failure to file its Annual Registration Report.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) states that parties shall not be allowed more than ten days in which to file a responsive pleading. More than ten days have expired since Staff filed its motion, yet the company has not responded.

Section 392.410(5), RSMo 2000, states: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected. . . ." The Commission has reviewed

Staff's motion and finds that granting the motion is reasonable. The Commission will cancel the certificate of service authority granted to Cable & Wireless USA, Inc., in Case No. TA-2001-505. The Commission will also cancel the company's tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of service authority granted to Cable & Wireless USA, Inc., in Case No. TA-2001-505, is canceled.
2. That the Cable & Wireless USA, Inc.'s tariff, Missouri PSC Tariff No. 5, is canceled.
3. That this order shall become effective on June 4, 2005.
4. That this case may be closed on June 5, 2005.
