Payment of a charge is satisfactory if received prior to the date upon which the charge becomes delinquent provided it is not in dispute. The Company may withhold refund of a deposit pending the resolution of a dispute with respect to charges secured by such deposit.
- 10. The deposit shall bear interest of nine (9) percent per annum which shall be credited annually upon the account of the customer or paid upon the return of the deposit, whichever occurs first. Interest shall not accrue on any deposit after the date on which a reasonable effort has been made to return it to the customer.
- 11. A quarantor shall be released upon satisfactory payment of all undisputed charges during the last twelve (12) billing periods. Payment of a charge is satisfactory if received prior to the date upon which the charge becomes delinquent provided it is not in dispute
- 12. At the option of the Company, a cash deposit may refunded or credited to the customer at any time protocolor to termination of service or the customers twelfth billing period.

- 4. The Company will make reasonable efforts to contact the customer via telephone at least twenty-four (24) hours preceding a discontinuance of basic local telecommunications service. The Company will advise the customer of the proposed discontinuance and what action must be taken to avoid it.
- 5. Discontinuance of service will be postponed for a time not in excess of twenty-one (21) days if the telephone is necessary to obtain emergency medical assistance for a person who is a member of the household where the telephone service is provided and where such person is under the care of a physician. Any person who alleges such emergency shall, if requested, provide the Company with verifiable written evidence of such necessity.
- 6. Basic local telecommunications service may not be discontinued for customer nonpayment of a delinquent charge for other than basic local telecommunications service. Company may place global toll blocking and eliminate any optional, non-basic calling features and functions for customer nonpayment of delinquent charges for other than basic local telecommunications service.

### Qualifying Low-Income Subscriber

A qualifying low-income subscriber is a subscriber who participates in one of the following programs: Medicaid; food stamps; supplemental security income; federal public housing assistance; or Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program.

## <u>Subscriber</u>

The individual, partnership, association, or corporation which contracts for telephone service and is responsible for the payment of charges and compliance with the rules and regulations of the Telephone Company.

### Telephone Station

A telephone instrument, consisting of a transmitter, receiver, and associated apparatus, so connected as to permit the transmitting and receiving of telephone messages.

1. Main Station: A station directly connected by means of a circuit with a central office. (T)

Extension Station: A station connected on the same circuit as the main station and having the same telephone number as the main station.

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## Toll Blocking

Toll blocking is a service provided by carriers that lets customers elect not to allow the completion of outgoing toll calls to the Long Distance Message Telecommunications Network, this would include 1+, 0+ and/or 0- operator handled calls.

A message from a calling station to a station located in a different local service area.

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# XIV. SALE OF TERMINAL EQUIPMENT

- Public Service Commission

  1. The Company may offer for sale to the general public items of telephone equipment, terminal equipment, and telephone accessory equipment that is not included in the Company's rate base for regulatory purpose. Applicable warranty coverage, if any, for specific items will be provided by the Company, in a written format, at the time of purchase.
- 2. Installed telephone sets and ancillary equipment existing on the customer's premise may be offered for sale. The minimum charge for such Company equipment in Account 231 shall be the net book value plus 5% of the sale price. The minimum charge for such Company equipment in Account 234 shall be the net book value plus the cost of the transaction.
- 3. The Company will establish and maintain separate and identifiable accounts with direct sale items in accordance with uniform system of accounts.
