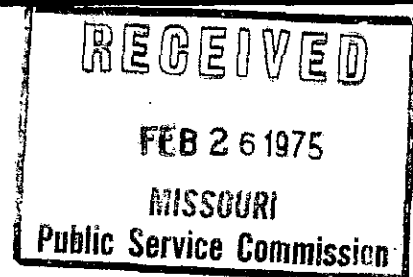

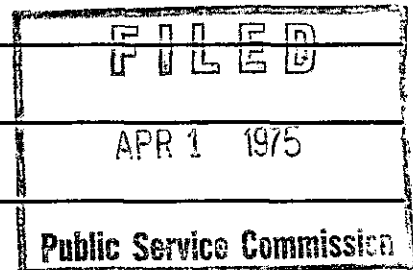

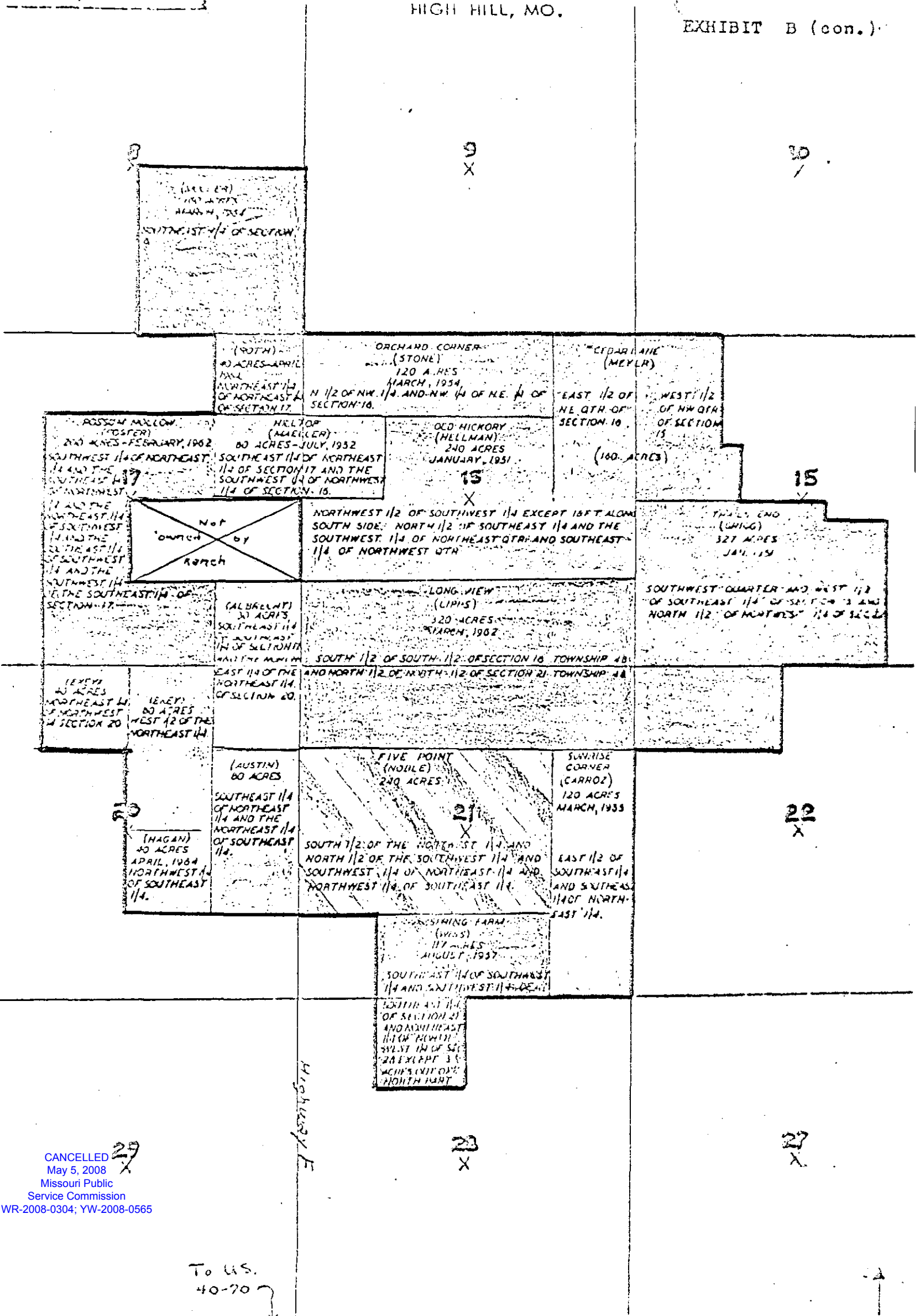

SUPPLY OF SERVICERule 1.

An application for meter installation and/or supply of service shall be made by each Consumer before Service is turned on to any premises. This application may be made by mail, or at the Company office. This application when accepted by the Company constitutes the contract between the Company and the Consumer, provided, however, that the Company shall have the right to reject any such application for the reason that customer has not abided by Rules and Regulations as applied by Missouri Public Service Commission.

Rule 2.

Application for general water service shall be for a minimum term of one (1) year.

Rule 3.

Where water is to be supplied to several users in tenements, apartments, or stores under one roof from one connection with supply controlled by one stop cock, the Company will supply service only to the owner or agent of said property.

Rule 4.

A cash deposit not to exceed estimated revenue for one (1) billing period plus thirty (30) days may be required from meter consumers to guarantee the payment of water bills and cost of repairs as set forth in Rule 17. Interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum, upon the return of any deposit covering the time of the deposit, shall be paid by the Company to the Consumer upon every cash deposit so required; provided said cash deposit remains with the Company for a period of at least six months.

No physical connection will be allowed between a service line from the mains of the Company and any pipe or tank which carries water of polluted or otherwise questionable character, or which is not a water supply approved by the State Board of Health of Missouri. Should such a cross connection be found, the Company will discontinue service to the consumers in question, after a 24 hour notice, unless all physical connections between the two water supplies have been severed.

All taps are to be made by licensed plumbers at Consumer's expense, subject to inspection and approval by the Company. Should such a cross-connection be found, the Company will discontinue service to the Consumer in question, after a 24-hour notice, unless all physical connections between the two water supplies have been severed.

All taps are to be made by licensed plumbers at Consumer's expense, subject to inspection and approval by the Company. Application, accompanied by a \$160.00 tapping and inspection fee, must be filed in writing 24 hours in advance stating the street, the house or lot number, name of applicant, name of property owner, size of service pipe and time at which tap is to be made. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Rule 9.

The service line from the main to the meter shall be ~~PVC Plastic~~, or other equivalent material (or better) approved by the Company, and not less than 3/4" in diameter. For service lines 2-1/2" and larger in diameter, cast iron pipe and fittings conforming to applicable specifications may be used. The service line must be laid out at right angles to the main and at right angles to the face of the building at the point where the service line enters the face of the building. At the property line necessary connections as specified by the Company shall be provided by the Customer for installation of a meter by the Company. If the service line cannot approach the main at right angles, special instructions must be obtained by the Plumber from the Company.

Rule 10.

Water services must be laid in trenches separate from sewer line trenches. The earth between the separate trenches shall not be less in width than the depth of the water service line below the finished grade. A shelf cut into the side of a sewer drain trench is not a separate trench within the meaning and requirements of this rule.

Rule 11.

The excavation for tapping a main must be free of mud and water and must be of sufficient size to allow the tapper to attach and operate the tapping machine.

Rule 12.

Consumers will not be permitted to extend service lines along public or private streets, or roadways, or through property of others in order to obtain connection to a water main.

Rule 13.

A brass stop and waste cock with lever handle, easily accessible to occupants, shall be placed in the service pipe inside the building at the point of entrance, and at such point that the water may be drained out of the pipes in the building.

Rule 14.

Service pipes must be installed at least 3-1/2 feet below surface of the ground and run to within one foot of water main if cast iron or PVC Plastic pipe is used, and to the center line of the main if copper pipe is used.

Rule 15.

All service pipes, valves, stop cocks, stop and waste cocks, stop boxes, curb and meter boxes which are the property of the Consumer, are to be kept in repair by the Consumer.

METER INSTALLATIONS

Rule 16.

Meters will be installed by the Company, and each meter will be and remain the sole property of the Company.

Rule 17.

Consumers must take necessary precaution to prevent pipes and meters from freezing in cold weather. The Company will make all ordinary repairs to meters, but in case meters are damaged through freezing, hot water backing up into meter, or other neglect of the Consumer, the cost of repairs will be assessed against the Consumer and payment for such repairs will be enforced the same as bills for water service.

Rule 18.

No person except a duly authorized employee of the Company or other person duly authorized by the Company shall set, change, remove or interfere with or make any connection to the Company's meter of appurtenances thereto.

ADJUSTMENT OF METER ERRORRule 19.

Consumer shall accept as standard of measurement the meter installed by the Company. Should the meter become defective or fail to register correctly, the quantity of water used shall be determined by a test of the meter, by the amount of water used during a corresponding period the preceeding year, or by an estimate based on the average amount of water used during the preceeding twelve months applied to the period during which the meter is shown to have become defective or inaccurate.

Rule 20.

The Company, at its expense, will make periodic tests and inspections of its meters in order to maintain them at a high standard of accuracy. The Company will make a test of the accuracy of any water meter, free of charge, upon request of a consumer, provided that the meter has not been tested within twelve months previous to such request.

Rule 22

The Company's managing officer or agent is authorized to limit by special rules and orders any use of water for the sprinkling of fields, gardens, orchards, lawns, parks, club grounds, streets, avenues or roads, or any unusual, unnecessary or wasteful use of water, and such officer or agent may prohibit and prevent the sprinkling of streets, avenues and roads, and other public places through the private service pipes or connections supplying the premises of water consumers. During the time of a fire, however, all such uses of water may be absolutely forbidden.

Rule 23

It is forbidden for Consumers to open any large valves or other openings and thereby to fill any tank, basin, reservoir, swimming pool or other large receptacle, except after first making arrangements with the Company's managing officer or agent for filling the same and then observing and conforming to the instructions of such officer or agent about the hours, the size of the pipes or hose, and other proper details as to the manner of filling any such tanks, receptacles, etc.

Rule 24

The inspectors or other authorized agents of the Company shall have access to the premises at all reasonable hours to make repairs and to see if the rules are observed.

During the time of a fire, however, all such uses of water may be absolutely forbidden.

Rule 23.

It is forbidden for Consumers to open any large valves or other openings and thereby to fill any tank, basin, reservoir, swimming pool or other large receptable, except after first making arrangements with the Company's managing officer or agent for filling the same and then observing and conforming to the instructions of such officer or agent about the hours, the size of pipes or hose, and other proper details as to the manner of filling any such tanks, receptacles, etc.

Rule 24.

The inspectors or other authorized agents of the Company shall have access to the premises at all reasonable hours to read meters, make repairs, and see if the rules are observed.
