ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

Issue Date: February 13, 2014

Effective Date: February 25, 2014

On April 26, 2007, United American Technology, Inc. ("United American Technology") was granted certificates of service authority to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri in File No. XA-2007-0337.

Pursuant to Section 392.210.1, RSMo (2000) every telecommunication company is required to file an annual report with the Commission. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.540(1) requires the annual report be filed no later than the 15th of April. United American Technology failed to file an annual report for calendar year 2012 with the Commission.

On November 14, 2013, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting United American Technology's certificate of service authority and associated tariff (Tracking No. JX-2007-0783) be cancelled due to United American Technology's failure to file a 2012 Annual Report. Staff also requested United American Technology be ordered to notify

the Commission upon completion of the transfer of its customers to other providers.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo Cum.Supp.2012, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

On November 14, 2013, the Commission issued an *Order Directing Notice* allowing any party to file an objection or request a hearing no later than December 16, 2013. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹

Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission shall cancel the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to United American Technology. United American Technology will be ordered to notify the Commission once the transfer of its customers to another provider is completed.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri, granted to United American Technology, Inc. in File No. XA-2007-0337 is cancelled.

2. United American Technology, Inc.’s tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, is cancelled.

3. United American Technology, Inc. shall provide written notice to the Staff of the Commission upon completing the transfer of company's existing customers to other providers.

4. This order shall become effective on February 25, 2014.
