## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On April 27, 2016, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for a certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to construct, install, own, operate, maintain and otherwise control and manage various small solar generation facilities at different locations within its service territory as part of a pilot program.

On April 28, 2016, the Commission issued an order directing notice of the application and setting a deadline of May 20, 2016 for persons requesting to intervene in this matter. Brightergy, LLC and Walmart Stores, Inc. filed timely applications to intervene. No party has objected to the applications to intervene. The applications satisfy all requirements of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075 and intervention will be granted.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application to intervene filed by Brightergy, LLC is granted.
2. The application to intervene filed by Walmart Stores, Inc. is granted.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
