NOTICE AND ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL, REJECTING TARIFFS AND CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: March 10, 2009 Effective Date: March 17, 2009

On March 10, 2009, iNetworks Group, Inc. ("iNetworks") filed a pleading captioned "Voluntary Dismissal" stating that it dismisses its application in the above referenced case.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) provides as follows:

(1) An applicant or complainant may voluntarily dismiss an application or complaint without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties. Once evidence has been offered or prepared testimony filed, an applicant or complainant may dismiss an action only by leave of the commission, or by written consent of the adverse parties.

No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case, and iNetworks has served a copy of this notice on all parties of record. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that iNetworks has voluntarily dismissed its application for a certificate of service authority to provide resold basic and interexchange telecommunications services and to classify iNetworks' services and the company as competitive.

In conjunction with its application, iNetworks filed local exchange and interexchange

services tariffs, each bearing an effective date of February 22, 2009. On February 18, 2009, iNetworks extended the effective date of the tariffs to March 2, 2009, but ultimately, the Commission suspended the tariffs until April 23, 2009. iNetworks' Voluntary Dismissal does not address the tariffs. Because iNetworks is dismissing its application for a certificate of service authority, and because it cannot provide service in Missouri without a certificate and tariffs, the Commission shall reject the tariffs.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission acknowledges iNetworks Group, Inc.'s Voluntary Dismissal.
- iNetworks Group, Inc.'s application for a certificate of service authority to provide resold basic and interexchange telecommunications services and to classify iNetworks' services and the company as competitive, filed on January 13, 2009, and amended on February 13, 2009, is dismissed.
- 3. The competitive local exchange and interexchange service tariffs, assigned tariff tracking numbers JL-2009-0504 and JL-2009-0505, submitted by iNetworks Group, Inc. on January 13, 2009, as amended on February 10 and 11, 2009 and suspended until April 23, 2009, are rejected.
