Enclosed for filing with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission is amended Sheet No. 42 to TNCI Operating Company LLC's ("TNCI OpCo") Missouri switched access Tariff, Missouri P.S.C Tariff No. 3, for incorporation into the Company's Tariff.

This submission is made pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") *Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*, in Docket Nos. WC Docket No. 10-90, et al., FCC 11-161, *Second Order on Reconsideration* in Docket Nos. WC Docket No. 10-90, et al., FCC 12-47, and Section 51.911 of the FCC's rules, 47 C.F.R. §51.911.

TNCI OpCo also reduces its intrastate Toll VoIP-PSTN traffic rates through adoption of the corresponding interstate terminating access rates contained in its Tariff F.C.C.
