SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL"), a Missouri corporation and Wilbur Strawn, enter into this Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") this 31st day of July 2007.

WHEREAS, KCPL is a regulated electrical utility serving residential, commercial and industrial customers in the Kansas City Metropolitan Area;

WHEREAS, KCPL provided electrical service to 4332 Cleveland Avenue, Kansas City, Missouri, 64130 ("4332 Cleveland"), a property owned by Mr. Strawn;

WHEREAS Mr. Strawn filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") concerning charges KCPL assessed against him concerning electric service at 4332 Cleveland (the "Complaint");

WHEREAS the Commission assigned Case No. EC-2007-0479 to Mr. Strawn's Complaint.

WHEREAS, Mr. Strawn and KCPL desire to settle the Complaint.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of these facts and circumstances, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Mr. Strawn shall pay to KCPL the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00). Per Mr. Strawn's request, that amount will be reflected on his next monthly bill from KCPL for service at 4332 Cleveland. Upon receipt of payment KCPL shall reconnect service at 4332 Cleveland.
- 2. In an effort to prevent the events that gave rise to the Complaint from reoccurring, Mr. Strawn agrees to notify KCPL when 4332 Cleveland becomes vacant. Once so notified, KCPL shall disconnect electric service to 4332 Cleveland at the pole as soon as commercially practicable.
- 3. In consideration of the foregoing, within ten (10) days of executing this settlement agreement Mr. Strawn agrees to withdraw his Complaint before the Commission with prejudice, and agrees to waive any right to resubmit a subsequent complaint concerning the same issues contained in the present Complaint.
