ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

Issue Date: September 19, 2008 Effective Date: September 29, 2008

On August 20, 2008, Ozark Technologies, LLC ("Ozark") filed an application asking the Commission to cancel their certificates of service authority and accompanying tariff. Ozark has been authorized to offer interexchange intrastate and non-switched local exchange private line telecommunications services by the Commission.

In Case Number TA-2001-133, the Commission granted Ozark a certificate to provide interexchange intrastate and non-switched local exchange private line telecommunications services. In the same case, Ozarks' tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, was also approved.

On September 5, 2008, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed their recommendation. Staff stated that the company is no longer providing telecommunications services in Missouri and has no customers in Missouri. Staff recommended the cancellation of the company's certificates and tariff.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Ozark's application to cancel the certificate and tariff and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the certificates of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to Ozark Technologies, LLC, shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- The certificate of authority to provide interexchange intrastate and non-switched local exchange private line telecommunications services granted to Ozark Technologies, LLC, in Case Number TA-2001-133, is canceled.
 - 2. Ozark's tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, is canceled.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on September 29, 2008.
 - 4. This case may be closed on September 30, 2008.
