ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

Issue Date: August 7, 2009 Effective Date: August 17, 2009

On July 23, 2009, Friendship Village of West County filed a letter asking the Commission to cancel the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff of Friendship Village of West County, a company that has been authorized to offer competitive interexchange telecommunications services by the Commission.

In Case Number TA-97-353, the Commission granted Friendship Village a certificate to provide competitive interexchange telecommunications services. Friendship Village's tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, was also approved.

On July 24, 2009, the Commission directed the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission to file a recommendation no later than August 3, 2009. On August 3, 2009, Staff filed its recommendation. Staff's recommendation states that Friendship Village owes no past assessments to the Commission and is not delinquent in filing an annual report. Staff further states that cancellation of the certificate of service authority and tariff is not detrimental to the public interest. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, to provide competitive interexchange telecommunications services.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Friendship Village's request to cancel the certificate and tariff, and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to Friendship Village of West County, shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The certificate of authority to provide competitive interexchange telecommunications services granted to Friendship Village of West County, in File Number TA-97-353, is canceled.
 - 2. Friendship Village's tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, is canceled.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on August 17, 2009.
 - 4. This case may be closed on August 18, 2009.

When a new Page is added between Pages already in effect, a decimal is added. For example, a new Page added between Pages 14 and 15 would be 14.1.
- B. Page Revision Numbers Revision numbers also appear in the upper right corner of each page. These numbers are used to determine the most current Page version on file with the PSCM. For example, the 4th revised Page 14 cancels the 3rd revised Page 14. Because of various suspension periods, deferrals, etc. the PSCM follows in its tariff approval process, the most current Page number on file with the Commission is not always the tariff page in effect.

Authorization Code - A pre-defined series of numbers to be dialed by the Customer or Authorized User upon access to the Carrier's Travel Card Service network to identify the caller and validate the caller's authorization to use the services provided.

Commission - Missouri Public Service Commission.

Company or Carrier - Friendship Village of West County unless otherwise clearly indicated by the context.

Customer - The person, firm, corporation or other entity which orders, cancels, amends or uses service and is responsible for payment of charges and compliance with the Company's tariff.

Debit Account - An account which consists of a prepaid usage balance depleted on a real time basis during each Debit Service Call.

Debit Card - A card issued by the Company which provides the Customer with a Personal Account Code and instructions for accessing the Carrier's network.

Debit Service Call - A service accessed via a Toll Free (i.e. 800/888) number or other access code dialing sequence whereby the customer or Authorized User dials all of the digits necessary to route a call. Network usage for each call is deducted from the Available Usage Balance on a Company-issued Debit Account.

Dedicated Access Origination/Termination - Where access between the customer and the interexchange carrier is provided on dedicated circuits. The cost of these dedicated circuits is billed by the access provider directly to the Customer.

End User - Any person, firm, corporation, partnership or other entity which uses the services of the Carrier under the provisions and regulations of this tariff. The End User is responsible for payment unless the charges for the services utilized are accepted and paid by another Customer.

Equal Access - Where the local exchange company central office provides interconnection to interexchange carriers with Feature Group D circuits. In such end offices, customers presubscribe their telephone line(s) to their preferred interLATA carrier.

Friendship Village - Used throughout this tariff to refer to Friendship Village of West County.

Initial Usage Balance - The amount of usage on a Debit Account upon issuance and before any depleting call activity.

LEC - Local Exchange Company.

Personal Account Code - A pre-defined series of numbers to be dialed by the Customer or Authorized User upon access to the Carrier's network which identifies the Debit Account from which charges for service shall be debited and which validates the caller's authorization to use the services provided.

Presubscribe - A method used to identify Friendship Village as the Customer's primary interexchange carrier and provides the Customer with direct dial "1+" long distance calling on Friendship Village's network.

Renewal - A method of replenishing a Debit Account's Available Usage Balance with additional minutes of use as authorized and paid for by the Customer.

2.1 Undertaking of Friendship Village of West County

Friendship Village's services and facilities are furnished for communications originating at specified points within the state of Missouri under terms of this tariff.

Friendship Village installs, operates, and maintains the communications services provided herein under in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth under this tariff. Services provided under this tariff may be used for any lawful purpose for which the service is technically suited.

- 2.4 Liabilities of the Company
 - 2.4.1 The liability of the Company for its willful misconduct or gross negligence which is the sole legal cause of damage or injury is not limited by this tariff. With respect to any other claim or suit, by a Customer or by any others, for damages associated with acts or omissions involving initiation, installation, provision, termination, maintenance, repair, interruption or restoration of any service or facilities offered under this tariff, the Company's liability, if any, is limited to the lesser of \$500 or the actual damages or injury sustained, which in the event of any failure of service shall be deemed to be 1/30 of the monthly charge for service affected for each 24-hour period during which such failure of service occurs and is reported to or known by the Company. In addition, Customer credits for interrupted service will be issued, where applicable, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.14.
 - 2.4.2 In no event will Company be responsible for consequential damages or lost profits suffered by Customer on account of interrupted or unsatisfactory service unless Company is found to have been willfully negligent.

2.5 Deposits

The Company reserves the right to examine the credit record of the Customer. If the Customer's financial condition is unknown or unacceptable to the Company, the Customer may be required to provide the Company with a security deposit intended to guarantee payment of bills for service. The amount of the security deposit for a new Customer shall not exceed two (2) months or sixty (60) days total billing (including toll and taxes) of estimated usage. For an existing Customer, the amount of the security deposit shall not exceed the highest billing of two (2) consecutive months or sixty (60) days (including toll and taxes) of actual usage within the preceding six (6) months. All deposits are subject to review based on the actual usage of the Customer and may be adjusted accordingly. The fact that a security deposit has been made in no way relieves the Customer from the prompt payment of bills upon presentation.

2.6 Advance Payments

The Company does not collect advance payments for service.

2.7 Taxes and Fees

The Company reserves the right to charge the Customer an amount sufficient to recover any governmental assessments, fees, licenses or other similar taxes or fees imposed upon the Company. Any surcharge or fee other than taxes will be filed for Commission approval.

- 2.7.1 For Debit Service, taxes or fees shall be included in the rates and charges stated in the Company's rate schedule for this service.
- 2.7.2 For all other services offered by the Company, taxes and fees shall be in addition to rates as quoted in this tariff, shall be added pro-rata, insofar as practical, and shall be listed as separate line items on the Customer's bill for services provided.

2.10 Payment for Service

The Customer is responsible for payment of all charges for services and equipment furnished to the Customer or to an Authorized User of the Customer by Friendship Village. Refusal or Discontinuance by Company

Friendship Village may refuse or discontinue service under the following conditions provided that, unless otherwise stated, the Customer shall be given fifteen (15) days notice to comply with any rule or remedy any deficiency:

- 2.13.1 For noncompliance with or violation of any State, municipal, or Federal law, ordinance or regulation pertaining to telephone service.
- 2.13.2 For use of telephone service for any other property or purpose than that described in the application.
- 2.13.3 For neglect or refusal to provide reasonable access to Friendship Village or its agents for the purpose of inspection and maintenance of equipment owned by Friendship Village or its agents.
- 2.13.4 For noncompliance with or violation of Commission regulation or Friendship Village's rules and regulations on file with the Commission, provided five (5) days' written notice is given before termination.

3.7 Debit Card Service

3.8 Public Pay Telephone Surcharge

MO. PUBLIC SERVICE COMM

In order to recover the Company's expenses to comply with the FCC's pay telephone compensation plan effective on October 7, 1997 (FCC 97-371), a per call charge is applicable to all interstate, intrastate and international calls that originate from any domestic pay telephone used to access the Company's services. This surcharge, which is in addition to standard tariffed usage charges and any applicable service charges and surcharges associated with the Company's service, applies for the use of the instrument used to access the Company service and is unrelated to the Company's service accessed from the pay telephone.

Pay telephones include coin-operated and coinless phones owned by local telephone companies, independent companies and other interexchange carriers. The Public Pay Telephone Surcharge applies to the initial completed call and any reoriginated call (i.e., using the "#" symbol).

Whenever possible, the Public Pay Telephone Surcharge will appear on the same invoice containing the usage charges for the surcharged call. In cases where proper pay telephone coding digits are not transmitted to the Company prior to completion of a call, the Public Pay Telephone Surcharge may be billed on a subsequent invoice after the Company has obtained information from a carrier that the originating station is an eligible pay telephone.

The Public Pay Telephone Surcharge does not apply to calls placed from pay telephones at which the Customer pays for service by inserting coins during the progress of the call.
