Dear Secretary Woodruff:

KCP&L seeks approval from the Missouri Public Service Commission of the enclosed revisions to its existing Low-Income Weatherization tariff sheets.

These tariff sheets modify some of the provisions contained in the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement Regarding Low-Income Weatherization ("Stipulation") filed on October 26, 2012 in Case No. ER-2012-0174 in order to reflect the fact that the City of Kansas City, Missouri will cease administering home weatherization programs in 2014.

Prior to filing, the Company provided a red-lined version of the requested tariff sheet revisions to the DSM Advisory Group stakeholders which includes parties to the Stipulation and requested comments be submitted by November 25, 2013. Minor comments were received and incorporated in the revised tariff sheets.
