If the installation and maintenance of service are requested at locations which are or may be hazardous or dangerous to the Telephone Company's employees or to the public or to property, the Telephone Company may refuse to install and maintain such service and, if such service is furnished, may require the subscriber to install and maintain such service and may also require the subscriber to indemnify and hold the Telephone Company harmless from any claims, loss or damage by reason of the installation and maintenance of such service.

2. Use of Subscriber Service

Subscriber telephone service, as distinguished from Payphone service, is furnished only for use by the subscriber, his family, employees or business associates, or person residing in the subscriber's household, except as the use of the service may be extended to joint users or to persons temporarily subleasing a subscriber's residential premises.

- a. The customer has undisputed charges in two out of the last twelve (12) billing period which have become delinquent. A telephone utility shall with respect to each customer maintain a COMM record of all charges which have become delinquent within the last twelve (12) billing periods.
- b. The customer has had service discontinued due to nonpayment of an undisputed delinquent charge or failure to post a required deposit or guarantee anytime during the preceding twelve (12) billing periods.
- c. The customer established service with the telephone utility within the preceding six (6) months, and incurs toll or other charges in any one (1) billing period which are equal to at least 400 percent of the amount of the deposit or guarantee previously required by the telephone utility.

In lieu of a deposit a telephone utility may accept a written guarantee. The limit of the guarantee shall not exceed the amount of a cash deposit. The guarantor shall be released upon satisfactory payment of all undisputed charges during the last twelve (12) billing periods. Payment of a charge is satisfactory if received prior to the date upon which the charge becomes delinquent provided it is not in dispute.

For businesses only a deposit may be required without the conditions stated above, when deemed appropriate under the aforementioned circumstances, in the form of provision of references, a suitable written guarantee, or cash.

No deposit or guarantee shall be required by the Telephone Company because of race, sex, creed, national origin, marital status, age, number of dependents, source of income of geographical area of residence.

A service deposit will not be required for Lifeline service, if the qualifying low-income customer voluntarily elects toll blocking, where available. If toll blocking is unavailable a service deposit may be charged.
