**ORDER CANCELING THE CERTIFICATES OF CONVENIENCE AND
NECESSITY OF SOUTHTOWN UTILITIES COMPANY, INC.**

On September 15, 2015, Southtown Utilities Company, Inc. (“Southtown”) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking authority to sell and transfer its sewer and water utilities to the City of Bolivar, Missouri (“Bolivar”). On November 4, 2015, the Commission issued an order granting Southtown’s application and directing Southtown to notify the Commission within five days after the closing of the sale and transfer of its assets to Bolivar.

On December 21, 2015, Southtown filed the ordered notice of the completed sale to Bolivar. The Commission will therefore cancel the certificates of convenience and necessity to provide water and sewer service originally granted to Southtown in Case No. WA-2005-0268. The Commission will also cancel Southtown’s water and sewer tariffs on file with the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate of convenience and necessity granted to Southtown Utilities Company, Inc. to provide water service is canceled.

2. The certificate of convenience and necessity granted to Southtown Utilities Company, Inc. to provide sewer service is canceled.

3. The following water tariff, assigned Tracking No. JW-2006-0367, is canceled:

P.S.C. MO No. 1

4. The following sewer tariff, assigned Tracking No. JS-2006-0368, is canceled:

P.S.C. MO No. 1

5. This order shall be effective when issued.

6. This file shall be closed on February 1, 2016.
