(2000) and, concurrent with this application, an associated tariff to allow Ameren Missouri to offer a pilot distributed solar program to customers. As part of this pilot, Ameren Missouri would own solar panels located on participating customers' property. Since a hearing is required pursuant to Section 393.170.3 RSMo., this will be a contested case and this notice is required. The issues that may come before the Missouri Public Service Commission in this case include whether a certificate should be granted and/or issues related to the proposed tariff.
