## APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

COMES NOW SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Advanced Solutions ("AT&T Advanced Solutions")<sup>1</sup>, pursuant to Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") Rule 4 CSR 240-3.513(6)(C), and hereby applies for approval by the Commission of the accompanying Amendment to Interconnection Agreement ("Amendment") voluntarily entered into by AT&T Advanced Solutions and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri").<sup>2</sup> In support of this Application, AT&T Advanced Solutions states:

1. AT&T Advanced Solutions is a Delaware Corporation, authorized to do business in the state of Missouri. Copies of its Certificate of Authority to transact business in Missouri from the Missouri Secretary of State and its Articles of Incorporation were filed in ReSBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. Application for a Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Advanced

Telecommunications within the State of Missouri, Case No. TA-2000-260, and are incorporated herein by reference. A copy of the registration of the fictitious name "AT&T Advanced Solutions" was filed with the Commission in Case No. XN-2006-0308, and is incorporated herein by reference. Pursuant to the Commission's Order Approving Interexchange And Non-Switched Local Exchange Certificate Of Service Authority in Case No. TA-2000-260, AT&T Advanced Solutions provides telecommunications service in Missouri. AT&T Advanced Solutions' principal office is located at 1010 N. St. Mary's Street, San Antonio, Texas 78215-2109.

AT&T Advanced Solutions has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of the Application. No Missouri annual reports or assessment fees are overdue.
- 4. On July 8, 2005, the Commission issued its <u>Order Approving Interconnection</u>. Agreement in Case No. TK-2005-0459, approving the underlying Interconnection Agreement between these parties. That Order provides: "Any proposed amendment must be submitted pursuant to Commission rule 4 CSR 240-3.513(6)."
  - 5. On October 19, 2005, AT&T Advanced Solutions and AT&T Missouri executed

the attached Amendment. This Amendment modified the pricing for the removal of all or nonexcessive bridged tap ("RABT"), and updated an operational provision in the interconnection agreement to reflect the improved provisioning interval for 2-wire and 4-wire copper xDSL loops from five to three days (as reflected in a CLEC Accessible Letter referenced in the Amendment). It is AT&T Advanced Solutions' understanding that the new RABT pricing is reflected in the RABT Appendix to many of the Successor M2As and, accordingly, has previously been presented to the Commission and approved. The second provision, as noted above, was previously announced to CLECs via an Accessible Letter. The Amenment is not discriminatory toward nonparties and is consistent with the public interest.

WHEREFORE, AT&T Advanced Solutions respectfully requests the Commission to approve the attached Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Advanced Solutions and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri.
