**ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND OTHER
PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS**

Issue Date: February 23, 2018

Effective Date: February 23, 2018

The Commission directed the Commission’s Staff to file a joint proposed procedural schedule, and Staff complied with that order on February 16, 2018. The Commission will adopt the proposed procedural schedule and order additional procedural requirements.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following procedural schedule is established:

Date	Event
March 5, 2018	Middleton’s response to Ameren’s Motion to Amend Order to Cease Disconnection or Restore Service
April 6, 2018	Second prehearing conference
April 27, 2018	Direct testimony or indication that complaint will be direct testimony (Middleton)
May 11, 2018	Rebuttal Testimony (Ameren)
May 25, 2018	Surrebuttal Testimony (Middleton)
June 5, 2018	Order of witnesses filed
June 6, 2018	Parties submit stipulation of undisputed facts
June 8, 2018	Evidentiary hearing

2. The parties shall appear at a prehearing conference in Suite 105 of the Wainwright State Office Building, 111 N. 7th Street, St. Louis, MO 63101, on April 6, 2018, at 11:00 a.m. Any person who needs additional accommodations to participate in the conference or hearing shall contact the Commission, not later than the day before the conference. Such contact shall be through the Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711. Any party may participate in the prehearing conference by telephone by dialing (573) 526-5808 or (866) 630-9351 at the start time of the conference.

3. The evidentiary hearing is scheduled for June 8, 2018, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The hearing will be held in Suite 105 of the Wainwright State Office Building, 111 N. 7th Street, St. Louis, MO 63101. Any person requiring additional accommodations to participate in the hearing shall call the Missouri Public Service Commission's Hotline at 800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 before the hearing.

4. The parties shall comply with the following additional procedural requirements:

A. All parties shall bring an adequate number of copies of exhibits that they intend to offer into evidence at the hearing. If testimony or documents are pre-filed and served on the parties before a hearing, a party need only provide a copy of the testimony or document to the court reporter as an exhibit at the evidentiary hearing. If an exhibit has not been prefiled, the party offering it must bring, in addition to the copy for the court reporter, copies for the five Commissioners, the Presiding Judge, and all counsel.


B. Exhibit numbers are assigned in the following manner:

C. Each party shall prepare a list of its pre-filed, pre-marked exhibits and submit a copy of that list to every other party and to the regulatory law judge no later than the morning of the evidentiary hearing. The lists shall not be filed in the EFIS case file. Exhibits that may be offered during cross-examination, but which have not been pre-filed, need not be included on the list.


