ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION

On January 2, 2007, Telcentrex, LLC ("Telcentrex") filed an application for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local and local exchange telecommunications services to prospective customers in the exchanges of certain incumbent local exchange carriers, including Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri, Embarq Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Embarq, CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel.

Telcentrex's application did not (and was not required to) contain a proposed tariff.¹ The Commission issued notice and established January 24, 2007 as the deadline for submission of requests to intervene. No one has asked to intervene.

¹ See Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(C), which provides that although a proposed tariff need not be filed simultaneously with an application for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange, local exchange, or basic local exchange telecommunications services, a tariff must be filed with and approved by the Commission before the applicant may actually begin providing such services.

The Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation before acting on Telcentrex's application.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall, by no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 12, 2007, file its recommendation regarding the application of Telcentrex, LLC.
2. This order shall become effective on February 5, 2007.
