STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, and submits its Status Report as follows:

1. On October 26, 2009, Broadview Networks, Inc. (“Broadview” or “the Company”) filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“the Commission”) its Application for Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Basic Local Exchange Telecommunications Service and for Competitive Classification (“Application”).

2. On November 16, 2009, the Commission issued its Order Directing Staff Status Report, ordering Staff to file by December 1, 2009, a pleading informing the Commission of a date by which Staff will file a recommendation.

3. Based upon an initial review of the Company’s Application, Staff notes that the Application, as filed, lacks certain information required by the Commission’s rules. Staff has communicated these deficiencies to the Company, which in turn has committed to supplement and/or amend its Application as soon as possible.

4. Based upon this commitment, Staff proposes to file its recommendation regarding the Company’s Application on or before December 23, 2009.

WHEREFORE, Staff submits this Status Report for the Commission’s information and consideration.
