**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO OBJECT TO ADMISSION OF LATE-FILED
EXHIBIT**

At the evidentiary hearing on this matter, Chairman Hall asked a witness for KCP&L and GMO to provide additional information, including scripts used by utility customer service representatives when transferring calls to Allconnect.¹ KCP&L and GMO responded to that request by filing additional information on February 8, 2016. KCP&L and GMO's response was not offered into evidence and has not been marked as an exhibit. Nevertheless, Staff cited and quoted from that response in its Initial Brief.² So that the record will be clear, the Commission will mark KCP&L and GMO's February 8 response, including attachments A, B, and C, as exhibit number 119, and will establish a time for the parties to file any objection to the admission of that exhibit.
