APPLICATION

Mark Twain Communications Company, hereinafter referred to as "Company", hereby submits this Verified Application for a certificate of service authority authorizing the Company to provide interexchange telecommunications services, including non-switched telecommunications services within the state of Missouri, and classification of such services as competitive. In support of this Application, Company states the following:

- 1. Company is a Missouri corporation, duly organized and existing under the laws of Missouri, with its principal place of business located at Highway 6 East, P.O. Box 128, Hurdland, Missouri 63547. A copy of Company's Certificate of Good Standing is attached hereto.
- 2. Company is an alternative local exchange telecommunications company competitively classified, and authorized to provide basic local exchange telecommunications service, and exchange access thereto in Missouri, as authorized in TA-98-305, and pursuant to this authority provides such service pursuant to tariffs in Missouri.

- 5. Company has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court that involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of the Application. No Missouri annual reports or assessment fees are overdue.
- 6. Company has the technical, managerial expertise and experience in the telecommunications industry to provide the services it proposes. Company has the financial wherewithal to provide the services it proposes. Company, via the current staff,

systems, and experience of its parent Mark Twain Rural Telephone Company, has been providing telecommunications services within Missouri in excess of 50 years.

- 7. Granting this request for service authority is in the public interest, in that it will increase the supply of providers providing interexchange and non-switched or dedicated private line / special access services within the state of Missouri, increasing the choices Missouri residents have for interexchange and non-switched services, including access to broadband capability.
- 8. Company hereby requests the Commission to issue Company service authority to provide interexchange and non-switched services within the state of Missouri. The Commission's May 19, 1998 Order in TA-98-305 granting Company basic local service authority stated the Company was already certificated to provide interexchange services, but that Order was corrected by the Commission's Order of July 23, 1998 in that regard.
- 9. Company further requests that the services offered pursuant to the authority requested herein be classified as competitive within the state of Missouri. The proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation than afforded similar services offered by incumbent rate of return local exchange telecommunications companies. Granting this Application is in the public interest as it will allow greater price and service options for telecommunications users.
- 10. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.150 (1) (c), the Company attaches tariff pages setting forth the terms, conditions, rules, and regulations applicable to the interexchange service it initially will provide.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, Company hereby requests that the Commission enter an Order or Orders authorizing Company to provide interexchange and non-switched services within the state of Missouri, approving the tariffs submitted with this Application, together with such other and further relief as is reasonable, necessary, or convenient to the affording the relief requested herein.


