A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now Lake Saint Louis Sewer Company ("Applicant"), pursuant to Section 393.170, RSMo 1978, and CSR 240-2.060, and states as follows:

1.

Applicant is a Missouri corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri, with its principal office and place of business located at One Lake Saint Louis Boulevard, Lake Saint Louis, Missouri 63367. It is a public utility rendering sewer service to the public under the jurisdiction of the Commission. A copy of its Certificate of Incorporation and Articles of Incorporation have previously been filed with this Commission.

Applicant requests permission, approval and a certificate of public convenience and necessity to install, own, acquire, construct operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area in St. Charles County, Missouri, as set

forth on the map attached to this application as Exhibit 1, and legally described by metes and bounds attached to this application as Exhibit 2.

4.

A feasibility study is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit 3. Detailed design and construction plans will be submitted to the Commission prior to the hearing on this matter.

5.

The area which applicant proposes to serve is not now located within any municipal boundaries. Applicant has previously complied with all legal requirements of the St. Charles County Court.

6.

Said sewer system will meet all of the requirements of the Commission and the Department of Natural Resources.

7.

There are no other public utilities or governmental bodies rendering the same or similar service which Applicant proposes to render within the area proposed to be served.

8.

The area requested is approximately two acres in size and 300 feet outside the existing boundaries of Applicant's certificated area. Only one customer is located on this property. It is a pre-school center which in order to open for business must demonstrate to St. Charles County that it can and will connect to a sanitary sewer system. Said proposed customer has executed a preliminary application for service which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit 4. Therefore, a public need exists for adequate sewer service within the area proposed to be served and the public convenience and necessity will be promoted by the granting of the authority herein requested.

9.

The name and address of the proposed customer is: Anthony Martin Giaimo, Route 2, 311-A South Service Road, O'Fallon, Missouri.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests the Commission to grant it permission, approval, and a certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to install, acquire, build, construct, own, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system for the public within the area referred to in paragraph 3 hereof and for such other and further orders as the Commission may deem meet and proper.

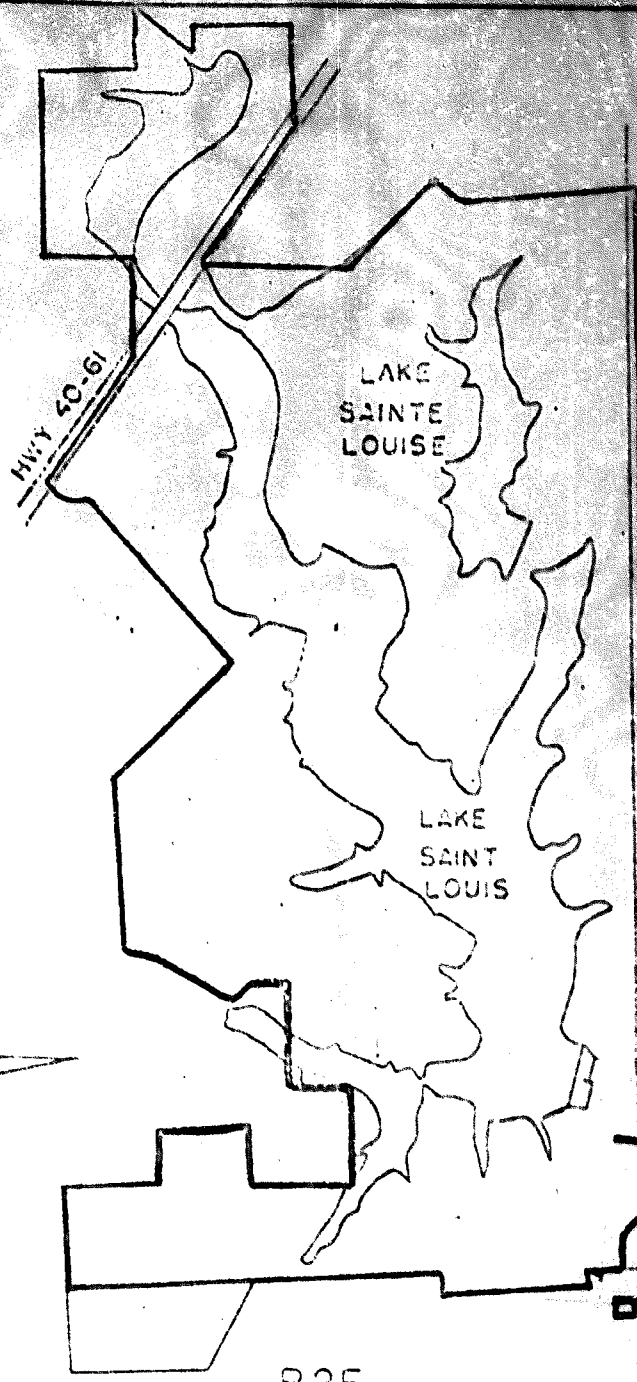

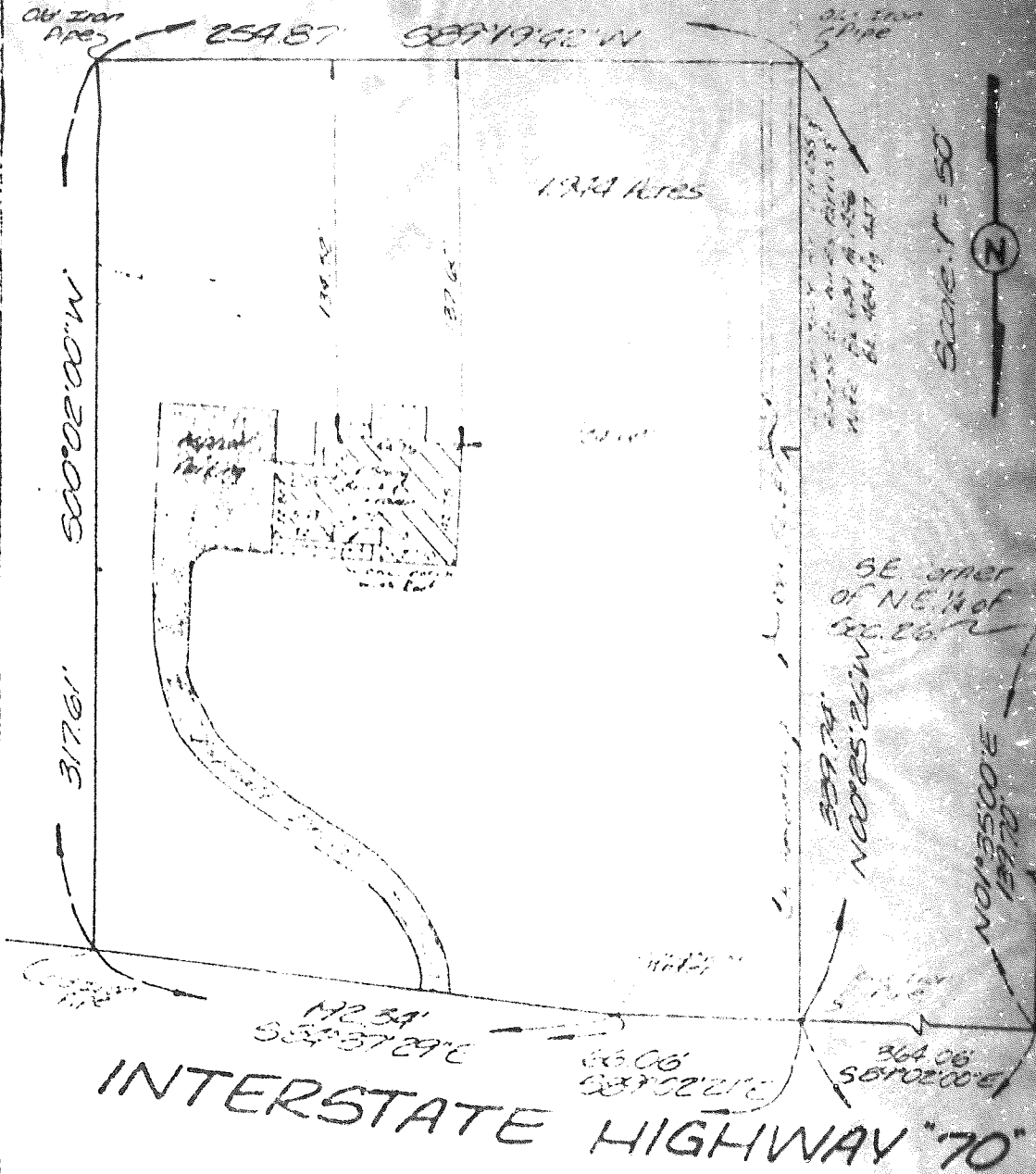

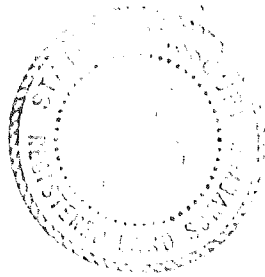

Feasibility Study - Heritage Academy

Data:

The Heritage Academy is a preschool with present capacity of 40 students with a staff of no more than 5 adults. Cooking facilities for lunches are available with no gymnasium, or showers.

BOD Loading = $45 \times .05 = 2.25\#/day$

Flow = $45 \times 12 = 540 \text{ gpd}$

Total Usage = 16,200 gallons per month

Revenue generated = \$19.54/month

Summary:

The owners of Heritage Academy have agreed to pay all costs to bring the necessary main line to their facility. The line will be dedicated to the company and the anticipated monthly revenue will be used for operation and maintenance costs. The new line will be an 8" gravity main and the projected income of \$19.54 per month will pay all operation and maintenance costs.

The organic loading provided by the Academy is equivalent to 10 residential homes and will not require additional treatment plant construction by the Lake Saint Louis Sewer Company.

APPLICATION FOR SEWER CONNECTION

The undersigned hereby requests permission to connect to the Lake Saint Louis Water and Sewer Co., hereinafter called Company, sanitary sewer system for a single family residence to be built at Lake Saint Louis on a tract of land as described on Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto.

Applicant agrees to abide by all rules and regulations applying to sewer service of Company filed with the Public Service Commission of Missouri and to pay the connection fee of \$280.00 and the inspection fee of \$10.00 with this application.

Applicant agrees to call Company at least 24 hours in advance to request inspection and further agrees not to connect the customer's sewer service to the main without an inspection and approval by Company. Company has the right to reject, for any valid reason, any application.
