After the filing of the Unanimous Stipulation in this case on October 4, 2000, it was brought to my attention that the first paragraph of the first page of the stipulation needed a correction. In its application, the Applicant had requested authority in the exchanges of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, (SWBT) GTE of the Midwest and Sprint. The first page of the stipulation, in error, recites that the authority is limited to SWBT and GTE exchanges.

UNANIMOUS STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

TELIGENT SERVICES, INC. (hereinafter "TSI" or "Applicant") initiated this proceeding on March 17, 2000 by filing an Application requesting certificate of service authority to provide <u>basic</u> local exchange and exchange access services in exchanges currently served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, GTE of the Midwest, Inc. (GTE), and Sprint.

Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) applied to intervene in this matter and its application was granted.

A. STANDARDS AND CRITERIA

1. The parties employed the following standards and criteria, which are intended to meet the requirements of existing law, particularly Sections 392.450 and 392.455, RSMo. Cum Supp. 1999 regarding applications for certificates of local exchange service authority to provide or resell basic local telecommunications service, in negotiating the provisions of this Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Stipulation").

2. For purposes of this Stipulation, the parties agree that applications for local exchange and basic local exchange service authority in exchanges served by "large" local exchange companies
