On March 23, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a complaint with the Commission against Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L), a copy of which is enclosed. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070 allows the Respondent 30 days from the date of this notice to file an answer or to file notice that the complaint has been satisfied, but that rule authorizes the Commission to set a different answer date if it so chooses.

Staff's complaint concerns an issue that has also been presented to the Commission in KCP&L's on going rate case, ER-2010-0355. Since the Commission's decision in that case may have an impact on KCP&L's response to Staff's complaint,

the Commission will require KCP&L to answer this complaint by June 3, 2011, which is thirty days after the May 4, 2011 tariff suspension date for that rate case.

This complaint is a contested case. As required by section 536.067(2)(f), RSMo 2000, the Commission informs the parties that the Commission's provisions governing procedures before the Commission, including provisions relating to discovery are found at Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.
