On July 10, 2012, 5LINX Enterprises, Inc. filed an application for registration to provide interconnected voice over Internet protocol service. 5LINX's application did not contain a signature, or the signer's street address, telephone number, facsimile number and electronic e-mail address. The application also failed to contain a completed certificate of service. Further, the affidavit attached to the application failed to provide the exchanges in which the company proposes to provide VoIP service, pursuant to §392.550.3(2), RSMo Cum. Supp. 2010. The Commission issued a Notice of Deficiency on July 11, 2012.

On July 26, 2012 5LINX requested recommendations to address the deficiencies and on July 30, the Commission directed the Staff of the Commission to respond to the request no later than August 9, 2012. On August 9, Staff filed a response indicating they have provided information to 5LINX.

The Commission will not take action on this application until the deficiencies are corrected. The Commission will leave the file open until September 12, 2012, to allow

5LINX to correct the deficiencies. If no response is filed by that time, the Commission will reject the application and close the file.
