On April 20, 2016, NTT America, Inc. filed an application for registration to provide interconnected voice over Internet protocol (“IVoIP”) service with the Missouri Public Service Commission, indicating its intention to offer and provide IVoIP services in the State of Missouri.


The application filed with the Commission was not sufficient in that the application was not signed by at least one attorney of record authorized to practice law in Missouri, as required by 4 CSR 240-2.080(1). In addition, the application filed with the Commission was not sufficient in that the attached affidavit failed to identify the exchanges in which the company proposes to provide IVoIP service, as required by §392.550.3(2), RSMo (Cumm. Supp. 2013).

On May 4, 2016, the Commission issued a Notice of Deficiency allowing the company to correct the deficiencies by May 16, 2016. No response was filed. Thus, the application will be rejected by the Commission. NTT America may file a new application in a new file if it chooses to do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application filed by NTT America, Inc. on April 20, 2016, is rejected.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
3. This file may be closed.
