**ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT**

On January 30, 2013, the Complainants filed a complaint against Kansas City Power & Light Company. Subsequently, the parties reached a settlement agreement to resolve their dispute. In compliance with that agreement, the Complainants filed a notice on November 1, 2013, requesting leave to dismiss their complaint.

The Commission’s rule regarding dismissal of complaints, 4 CSR 240-2.116(1), provides that after testimony has been filed, a complainant can dismiss its complaint only by leave of the Commission. Complainants’ request for leave to dismiss the complaint is granted and the complaint is dismissed.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Complainants’ request for leave to dismiss complaint is granted and this complaint against Kansas City Power & Light Company is dismissed.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
