ORDER MODIFYING TIME TO FILE MONTHLY UPDATE REPORTS

The Commission established this working case to gather information about the effect of the COVID-19 pandemic on the collection of past-due utility customer payments. The Commission ordered its Staff to collect information from the utilities about customer disconnections and to file an initial report by September 21, 2020¹ and thereafter to file monthly updates by the 15th of each month, continuing through December, 2020, or until otherwise ordered. Staff filed its initial report on September 21, and filed an update on October 15.

As part of its monthly update report, Staff asked that it be allowed until the 22nd of each month to file its update report. Staff explained that the utilities have been slow to provide monthly information to Staff and that as a result Staff has been left with little time to analyze the information it has received. The Commission finds that Staff's request for an additional week to file its monthly report is reasonable and will grant that request.
