ENTRY OF APPEARANCE

COME NOW Dean L. Cooper and Diana C. Carter of Brydon, Swearingen & England, P.C., and hereby enter their appearance herein on behalf of The Empire District Electric Company (“Empire”).

On February 1, 2007, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCPL”) submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided by KCPL in its Missouri service area. By the Commission’s Order and Notice issued February 6, 2007, the Commission established an intervention deadline of March 7, 2007.

The Commission also provided, however, that all non-KCPL signatory parties to the stipulation approved in Commission Case No. EO-2005-0329 were being named as intervenors herein. Further, in Case No. EO-2005-0329, the Commission-approved stipulation provided that all non-KCPL signatories could intervene as a matter of right in this proceeding. Empire was a party to said case and a signatory to said stipulation. Therefore, it is Empire’s understanding that it has already been granted intervention status herein and is not filing a motion to intervene pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075.
