## Objections of the Missouri Landowners Alliance to Certain Evidence Submitted by Mr. Alan Spell

The Missouri Landowners Alliance objects to the following pre-filed testimony and Schedules of Mr. Alan Spell:

- 1. Schedule AES-2 to the rebuttal testimony of Mr. Spell (the document compiled by Dr. Loomis), on the ground that this document is inadmissible under the terms of Section 536.070(11) RSMo, as discussed more fully in paragraph 7 of the Motion of Missouri Landowners Alliance to Strike Certain Pre-Filed Evidence on the Basis of Section 536.070(11) RSMo, filed on March 6, 2017.
- 2. Mr. Spell's Economic Impact Study, which was submitted as Schedule MOL-7 to Mr. Lawlor's direct testimony, was dependent on inputs from Mr. Spell's Schedule AES-2, as discussed more fully in the Motion of Missouri Landowners Alliance to Strike Certain Pre-Filed Evidence on the Basis of Section 536.070(11) RSMo, filed on March 6, 2017. Therefore, the Economic Impact Study is inadmissible<sup>1</sup>, as are the following portions of Mr. Spell's rebuttal testimony which discuss the results of that Study: page 2 line 13 to page 4 line 5; and page 7 lines 7 to 18.
