PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

Comes now Stoneshire Water Co., a Missouri Corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Applicant" and respectfully states:

- 1. That the applicant is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri, and has its principal offices and place of business at Route 1, Box 163A, Highlandville, Missouri. A copy of its Certificate of Incorporation and Articles of Incorporation and hereto attached and marked Exhibit "1" and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. Communications in regard to the applicant should be addressed to Don D. Anderson, President, Stoneshire Water Co., 5425 Southwood Rd., Springfield, Missouri, 65804, and Anthony McConnell, Attorney at Law, P.O. Box 158, West Public Square, Ozark, Missouri.
- 3. By this application, the applicant seeks a Certificate of public convenience and necessity to build, construct, operate and maintain a water distribution system and all other facilities, including the acquisition of easements, rights of way, land, drilling of wells, reservoirs, necessary for the purpose of furnishing potable water to the public in the area described as follows:

Applicant, on or before the hearing, will file a service map showing the boundaries of the above described area for which a certificate of convenience and necessity is now requested. Applicant states that there are no water companies under jurisdiction of the commission being operated or rendering service within the area proposed to be served. Applicant states that the area proposed to be served is rapidly being developed into subdivision and that there are many homes and establishments being planned in the near future within said area, all of which will need adequate water supply. The applicant is financially able to construct said water The amount and nature of additional financing, if any, except system. interim borrowing, will be submitted to the commission for approval, if and as funds are required for construction. The applicant will present up to date financial exhibits at the hearing on this application and on or before the hearing, the applicant will also file and present complete engineering surveys, plans and specifications of said project together with a feasibility study showing all necessary data and information concerning said

facilities and projects. Such plans and specifications will show that the system will meet all applicable requirements of this commission and the Missouri Division of Health.

- 9. The applicant will present at the hearing its proposed rates and charges for the rendering of water service to the public in said area.
- 10. Applicant states that there is and will be a public need for adequate water service within the area proposed to be served and that public convenience and necessity will be promoted by the granting to the applicant the authority herein requested.
- 11. There are no municipalities located within the proposed area.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests the commission to grant it a certificate of Convenience and Necessity authorizing it to acquire, build, construct, operate, and maintain a water distribution system and all other facilities necessary for the purpose of furnishing adequate and potable water to the public within the area above referred to and for such further orders as the commission may deem proper.

The preferences, qualifications, limitations, restrictions, and the special or relative rights, including convertible rights, if any, in respect of the shares of each class are as follows:

There is reserved to the Corporation, and then to the existing shareholders, the right to purchase and acquire the stock of a selling shareholder before selling to a non-shareholder, but this restriction shall not be construed as a requirement that a selling shareholder shall sell his shares for less than the book value at the time of the proposed sale. Each existing shareholder so desiring to purchase the stock of a selling shareholder shall have the right to purchase such portion of that stock as the number of the shares owned by him bears to the total number of shares owned by all the shareholders so desiring to purchase. The option hereinabove granted to the corporation and shareholders, if not exercised within 90 days shall be void and of no effect. This restriction shall be plainly printed or typewritten on each certificate of stock issued by the Corporation.
