

1. Qwest Communications Corporation, Qwest Interprise America, Inc. and OnFiber Carrier Services are providing two copies of the Annual Report to the Missouri Public Service Commission (the "Commission"); one to be kept under seal and a redacted public version.
 - a. The redacted public version excludes the Total Company operating revenues that are to be reported on Page 3 of the Annual Report.
2. Total Company operating revenues should be kept under seal because public disclosure of this information would seriously impair the competitive position of Qwest Communications Corporation, Qwest Interprise America, Inc., OnFiber Carrier Services and their affiliates (collectively, "Qwest") and could unfairly provide an advantage to Qwest's competitors. This information has not previously been made public, and, subject to the Commission's grant of the request for this information to be kept under seal, will remain confidential. The telecommunications industry is highly competitive. Disclosure of stand-alone financial information for Qwest Communications Corporation, Qwest Interprise America, Inc. and OnFiber Carrier Services would give Qwest's competitors critical information regarding Qwest's financial and operating structure that is not otherwise publicly available. Qwest's competitors generally are not required to, and have not, disclosed similar information about their operations.
3. Total operating revenues for Qwest Communications Corporation, Qwest Interprise America, Inc. and OnFiber Carrier Services are not disclosed publicly.
 - a. Qwest Communications Corporation, Qwest Interprise America, Inc. and OnFiber Carrier Services are not subject to the reporting requirements of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended.

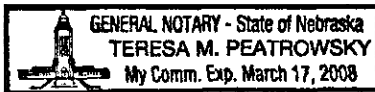

The company name listed on the cover page should include any commission approved AKA/DBA/Fictitious Name, if applicable. In addition, the company's name should be clearly identified throughout each page of the report, in the spaces provided and should be identical to the name shown on the cover page.
- If additional space is needed for entering information on a specific page, please insert a page and copy the existing page template.
- After the annual report is completed, save the file, print the form and prepare for mailing or electronically submitting through EFIS, as a non-case related submission.

Requests to submit annual report data under seal:

In order to take advantage of this procedure, the submitter, either through EFIS or in hard copy form, must:

A. Provide both a fully completed version to be kept under seal and a redacted public version that clearly informs the reader that the redacted information has been submitted under seal. The cover of each version must clearly identify whether it is the public or the non-public version. Each page of each version of the report containing non-public information should be clearly identified as containing such information.

B. Submit both versions of the annual report with a cover letter stating that the utility is designating some or all of the information in its annual report as confidential information, including the name, phone number and e-mail address (if available) of the person responsible for addressing questions regarding the confidential portions of the annual report.

C. Prominently attach a detailed affidavit to both versions that identifies the specific types of information to be kept under seal, provides a reason why the specific information should be a closed record, and stating that none of the requested information is available to the public in any format.

(g) The installation and maintenance of inside wire within a customer's premises;

(h) Electronic publishing services; or

(i) Services provided pursuant to a broadcast radio or television license issued by the Federal Communications Commission;

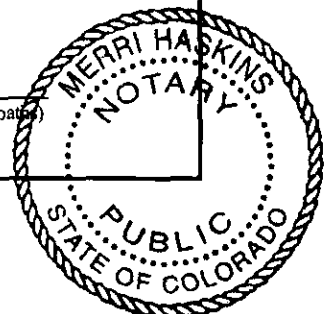
