Behnen's Container Service ("Customer") is an existing customer of the Company and presently takes service from the Company under Rate Schedule 4(M), Small Primary Service, at its facility located at 355 Paul Avenue, Ferguson, Missouri. Electric service is currently supplied at this facility through a 750 kV, three-phase transformer owned by the Company and leased to the Customer. No other customers are served through this transformer.

4. The Customer has requested to purchase this transformer and the Company is willing to sell the transformer to the Customer for a purchase price of \$5,439.70, "as is" under the terms and conditions set forth in the Bill of Sale, attached hereto as Appendix 1. The Customer would be required to maintain the transformer after taking ownership thereof.

5. If the sale is consummated, the Company would continue to provide electric service to Customer as before.

6. The facility in question is treated for tax purposes as "distributable property" and is thus allocated to and subject to taxation by all Missouri political subdivisions in which the Company has property. Accordingly, in compliance with the requirement of Section 393.190, RSMo. 2000 and 4 CSR 240-3.110(1)(F), that the Company submit herewith a statement showing the impact from the proposed sale on the tax revenues of the political subdivisions in which it has any facilities, the Company states as follows: due to the large number of taxing authorities to which this property is allocated and the extremely small dollar amount of the property proposed to be sold, any such tax impacts would be de minimis.

7. The Company respectfully suggests that this sale will not be detrimental to the public interest and should therefore be approved. The sale of the transformer has been requested by the Customer and agreed to by the Company. No other customer's service will be impacted by the sale, and the sale will have negligible impact on the Company's rate base. Thus, neither the Company nor its other customers will be adversely affected by the sale. The sale would not be detrimental to the public interest and should therefore be approved.

8. Other than cases that have been docketed at the Commission, AmerenUE has no pending actions or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal court or agency within the past three (3) years which involve customer service or rates. AmerenUE has no annual report or assessment fees that are overdue.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Union Electric Company respectfully requests that the Commission approve the sale to Behnen's Container Service of the transformer described herein.

It is understood that Vendor does not warrant the title to any right-of-way or easement upon which the property herein described is or may be located.

The parties hereto acknowledge that each has read this agreement, understands it and agrees to be bound by its terms. The parties further agree that this document constitutes the full understanding of the parties, and no terms, conditions, understandings or agreements purporting to modify or vary the terms of this document shall be binding unless hereafter made in writing and signed by both parties hereto.
