NOTICE OF COMPLAINT AND ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND

On January 13, 2015, Fred Sauer filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri and against the Missouri Public Service Commission. Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070, the Respondents have thirty days from the date of this notice to file an answer or to file notice that the complaint has been satisfied. Since this notice is being issued on January 15, 2015, the thirty-day period will expire on Saturday, February 14, 2015. The Respondents' answers are due no later than Tuesday, February 17, 2015.¹

As an alternative to the formal complaint process, the Commission offers voluntary mediation. If the parties agree to mediation, the Commission may suspend the answer date while the mediation proceeds.

This is a contested case. As required by Section 536.067(2)(f), RSMo 2000, the Commission informs the parties that the Commission's provisions governing procedures before the Commission, including provisions relating to discovery, are found at Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090.
